Articles of Incorporation,
The Thunder Mountain and Lightning Peak Gold Mines Co.

Article -- 1 --

We, the undersigned, Miles C. Moore, J. W. Baker, and J. B. Moore, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes hereinafter specified, do associate ourselves together under the laws of the State of Washington in relation to corporations and hereby form and organize a corporation.

Article -- 2 --

The Name of this corporation shall be The Thunder Mountain and Lightning Peak Gold Mines Co.

Article -- 3 --

EXPIRATION -- This corporation shall exist for a period of fifty years unless sooner dissolved in the manner prescribed by the laws of the State of Washington.

Article -- 4 --

CAPITAL STOCK -- The Capital Stock of this corporation shall be two million dollars, divided into two million shares of the par value of one dollar each.

Article -- 5 --

OBJECTS -- The objects of this corporation are, and it is formed and organized for the following purposes, to-wit:
1st. To engage in a general mining, milling and smelting business.
2nd. To buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate all kinds of mines, mining property, mining stocks, mills, real estate and interests therein.
3rd. To buy, sell, operate, develop and work mines and mills in Washington, Idaho, Oregon and British Columbia.

Article -- 6 --

PLACE OF BUSINESS -- The office and principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the city of Walla Walla, County of Walla Walla, and state of Washington.

Article -- '7 --

TRUSTEES -- The number of the trustees of this corporation shall be five, who shall manage the business affairs of said corporation with the authority given and in accordance with the laws of the state of Washington, and the trustees for the first six months shall be M.C.Moore, J.A.Finch, W.B.Moore, I.L.Root, and J.J.Baker.
