ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

GLO CLEANERS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we have associated ourselves together to form, and do form a business corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and adopt as articles of incorporation therefor, and certify the following as such articles:

Ι.

NAME. The name of this corporation shall be GLO CLEANERS, INC., but the corporation may use business names as allowed by law and asconvenience may require.

II.

PEGISTERED ADDRESS AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS. The registered address of this corporation shall be Boise, Idaho, where its principal place of business shall also be; and until otherwise provided by the By-Laws its principal place of business in Boise, Idaho shall be at 6409 Ustick Road. Other places of business may be established in or out of Idaho as convenience may require.

III.

DURATION. This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

IV.

FURPOSES AND OBJECTS. As its purposes and objects it is declared that the intention of this corporation is to do a general cleaning, dyeing, laundry, tailoring, renovating and merchandising business; and the corporation shall have power to engage in business enterprises in general, and in particular in all fields allied to those specifically stated; andmay contract, buy and sell real and personal property, issue notes, bonds, debentures, incur and give security of any class for its obligations; and have and exercise all of the powers allowed to business corporations for profit under the provisions of the Uniform Business Corporations Act of Idaho.

V.

DIRECTORS. The corporation shall be governed by a board of three directors, who shall hold office for one year and until their successors are elected and qualified, and shall be elected at the annual meeting of the shareholders.

CAPITALIZATION. The corporation shall have fifty thousand shares of common stock, all of one class and of the par value of one dollar per share. All voting rights shall be equal, one vote to a share. The aggregate of such shares is \$50,000.00.

VII.

OFFICERS. The corporation shall have a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer. The By-Laws may provide for holding of several offices by one person.

VIII.

FIRST DIRECTORS. The first board of directors shall be William M. Anderson, Vernon L. Anderson and Phyllis A. Anderson, who shall hold office until the second Monday of July, 1964 and thereafter until their successors are elected and qualified.

TX.

SEAL. The comporation shall have a common seal bearing the comporate name and such other matters as may be required by law; the secretary shall have custody of the seal.

χ.

INCORPORATORS. The names and addresses of the incorporators and the shares of stock subscribed by each are as follows:

William M. Anderson, 1422 South Roosevelt, Boise, Idaho, 7,500 shares of common stock.

Phyllis A. Anderson, 1122 South Goosevelt, Boise, Idaho, 7,500 shares of common stock.

Bettie M. Anderson, 1910 Harrison Boulevard, Boise, Idaho, 4,533 shares of common stock.

Vernon L. Anderson, 1910 Harrison Boulevard, Boise, Idaho, 4,532 shares of common stock.

XI.

PRE-EMPTIVE TIGHT TO PURCHASE STOCK. The unsubscribed stock of the corporation shall not be sold on the public market, norto any person not listed in Article X herein without written consent of three fourths of the shareholders. The incorporators reserve the right to purchase the unsubscribed capital stock as follows: To William M. Anderson and Phyllis A. Anderson, his wife, or either of them such a number of shares that in the aggregate, between them, they will hold 51% of the stock; to Bettie M. Anderson and Vernon L. Anderson, husband and wife, such a number of shares that in the aggregate, between them, they will hold 49% of the stock.

GENERAL ADOPTION OF LAW. In all matters which are not specifically provided for herein or in the By-Laws, this corporation shall be governed by, and it does adopt the provisions of Chapter 1, Title 30, Idaho Code, the amendments of which shall be deemed from time to time amendments hereof and incorporated herein.

ELECTION OF OFFICERS. The officers shall be elected by the directors and unless so required by law neither officers nor directors need be shareholders.
