ARTICLES of INCORPORATION of the IDAHO-WASHINGTON

RESOURCE CONSERVACION and DEVELOPMENT

COUNCIL, INCORPORATED

The undersigned, in order to form a corporation for the purpose hereinafter stated, and in accordance and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation is Idaho-Washington Resource Conservation and Development Council, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II - TYPE OF CORPORATION

Idaho-Washington Resource Conservation and Development Council, Incorporated is a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III - DURATION

The duration of the existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSE

The corporation is organized for the purpose of promoting the education, planning, development, and implementation of programs which will improve and enhance the social, economic, and environmental conditions within the corporation's geographical boundary of Benswah, Kootenai, Shoshone, Boundary, Bonner Counties in Idaho and Ferry, Stevens, Pend Orielle, Spokane, Whitman Counties in Washington.

ARTICLE VI - MANAGEMENT

Management of the corporation is vested with the mambers. A Board of Directors shall exist to manage specific activities, with limited authorities granted by the mambers and set forth in the by-laws, pursuant to section 30-314 (c) of the Idaho Code. The initial Board of Directors shall be the same individuals listed as the Incorporators in Article XI.

ARTICLE VII - SURPLUS FUNDS AND DISSOLUTION

The corporation is not organized for monetary profit and shall have no power to declare dividends. No part of any income shall accrue to the benefit of any member, or any private persons except that the corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

In the event of dissolution of this corporation, all business, property, and assets of the corporation shall be distributed to Idaho Association of Soil Conservation Districts, which is a non-profit corporation, organized and operated for educational and conservation purposes, and has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

In the event Idaho Association of Soil Conservation Districts is no longer in existence and/or no longer a qualified distributee, unwilling or unable to accept the distribution, the assets shall be distributed to Western RC&D Association, which is a non-profit corporation, organized and operated for educational and conservation purposes, and which has established its tax exempt status under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VIII - ALLOWABLE ACTIVITIES

Not withstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not engage in any other activities not permitted (a) by a corporation exampt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
