ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CENTRAL IDAHO AQUANAUTS PARENTS CLUB, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we the undersigned, have associated and do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit corporation, pursuant to Title 30, Chapter 3 of the Idaho Code, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, and do hereby make, subscribe and certify as follows:

ARTICLE 1.

The name of the corporation is Central Idaho Aquanauts
Parents Club, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The location of the registered office of the corporation shall be Box 92, Kamiah, Idaho 83536. The initial registered agent is Vikki Landmark, Kamiah, Idaho 83536.

ARTICLE III.

This is a non-profit organization, no part of the incorporation of which is distributable to its members, directors, or officers.

ARTICLE IV.

This said corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V.

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are to do any and all things hereinafter set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world so long as the pecuniary profit is not their object, namely:

a. To make available to the youth of the area an opportunity for wholesome water activities.

b. To further efforts to provide such youth with the opportunity to engage in both competitive and non competitive swimming.

c. To enhance and enjender interest of the youth of the area in swimming sports.

d. Any money or donations to the corporation shall be used solely to promote the non-profit and charitable purposes set forth herein. The corporation shall not engage in any activities procluded under the Internal Revenue Code by corporations which are tax exempt, but which may receive tax exempt contributions and no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be to promote propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation and the corporation shall not support or oppose any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE VI.

The corporation shall be non-stock and no dividends or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof. This corporation shall issue membership certificates to each member hereof, the qualifications of being and becoming a member shall be fully set out in By-Laws of this Corporation and said certificate cannot be assigned except by resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the By-Laws may provide.

ARTICLE VII.

The general officers of the corporation shall be President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, and the offices of secretary and treasurer may be combined, and the Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) members.

The principal duties of the officers of the corporation shall be the usual and regular duties as those usually prescribed for the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer of the corporation, which duties are more particularly outlined in the laws of the State of Idaho, and will be more particularly defined in the By-Laws herein adopted. Said officers shall perform such additional and different duties as shall be from time to time imposed or required by the Board of

1 Directors or as may be prescribed from time to time by the
2 By-Laws. Each and every officer of this corporation and member
3 of the Board of Directors must be a member of this corporation.

5 ARTICLE VIII.

6 The private property of the members of the corporation
7 shall not be subject to the payment of, and no member shall be
8 individually responsible for, corporate debts or acts to any
extent whatever without his consent thereto in writing.

10 ARTICLE IX.

11 The rights and interest of all members shall be equal and
12 no member shall have or acquire a greater interest therein than
any other member.

13
14 ARTICLE X.

15 At each election for directors every member entitled to
16 vote at such election shall have the right to vote, by person or
17 by proxy, for as many persons as there are directors to be
18 elected and for whose election he has the right to vote, or, to
19 cumulate his vote by giving one (1) candidate as many votes as
20 the number of such director multiplied by his vote to equal, or
21 by distributing such votes on the same principal among any
number of such candidates.

23 ARTICLE XI.

24 The By-Laws of the corporation may define and fix the
25 duties and responsibilities of the members and prescribe such
26 other terms and conditions upon which members shall be entitled
27 to and retain membership in the corporation consistent with
28 these Articles of Incorporation or the acts under which this
corporation is organized.

30 ARTICLE XII.

31 The names and post office addresses of the incorporators
32 and initial board of directors of said corporation are as
follows, to wit: (All of whom are full age citizens of

the United States), John Roberts, P.O. Box 1862, Orofino, Idaho 83544; Gary DeHaas, 905 South "C", Grangeville, Idaho; and Vikki Landmark, P.O. Box 92, Kamiah, Idaho 83535.

ARTICLE XIII.

The By-Laws of this corporation may be altered, amended or repealed, or new By-Laws adopted and such right is vested in the members of the said corporation although such power may be delegated by the members to the Board of Directors. The By-Laws may contain provisions, not inconsistent with the law, or with the Articles of Incorporation, for the regulation; of management or the affairs of the corporation.
