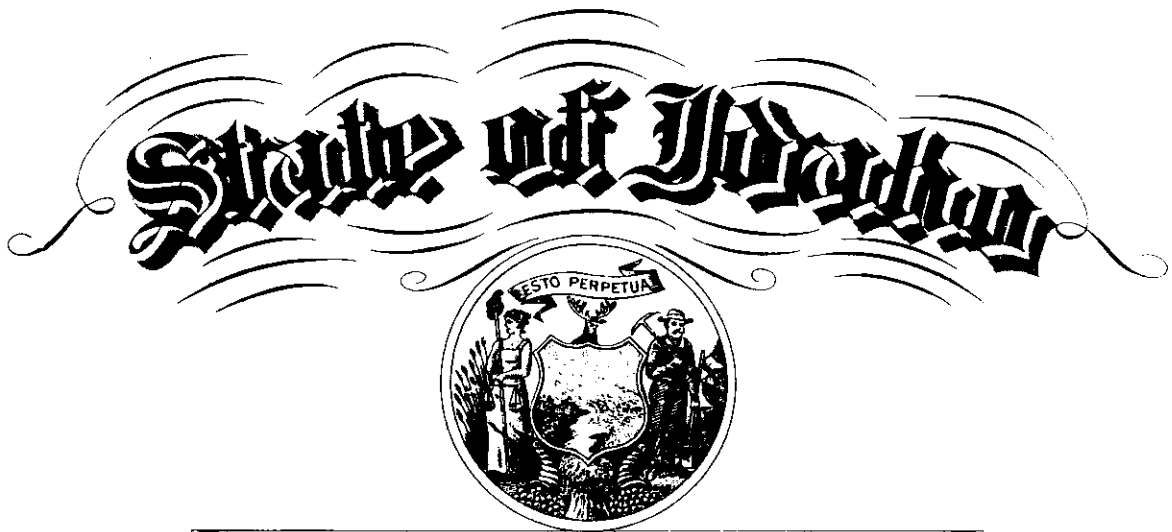

for market any and all types and kinds of livestock; and to own and/or operate livestock auction sale rings and any and all types and kinds of livestock markets, livestock feed yards, livestock holding pens and livestock shipping facilities.

b. To buy, sell, and otherwise dispose of, trade and deal in any and all kinds of farm products, or livestock, or the by-products of farming or livestock raising or any other kinds of products arising from farming; to engage generally in the business of wholesale and retail buying and selling of goods, wares, merchandise, livestock and livestock feeds and any and all other types and kinds of personal property whatsoever.

c. To receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage, and/or lease, real and personal property; to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of the corporation, other than its franchise of being a corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guaranty, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, pledge and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, domestic or foreign.

d. To conduct business in this state, other states, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States and in foreign countries, and to have one or more offices and places of business out of this state, and to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of and/or convey real and personal property situate out of this state.

e. To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, state or government, or any subdivision, district or department thereof.

f. To do any and all such other acts, things, business or

businesses in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation; and in carrying on its purposes, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business.

4. The several clauses contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the statements contained in each clause shall be in nowise limited or restricted, by reference to, or inference from, the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no limitation, restriction, or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes herein enumerated shall be deemed to be exclusive; but it is hereby expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are hereby included.

III.

That the location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

IV.

That the duration and existence of this corporation is to be perpetual.

V.

That the amount of the authorized stock of said corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand (100,000) Dollars, divided into one thousand (1000) shares of common stock of the par value of One Hundred (100.00) Dollars each.

Twin Falls Livestock Commission Company was incorporated on April 28, 1953, and has been doing business in Twin Falls since that time.

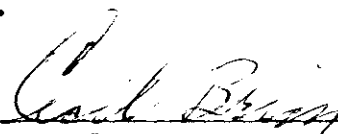
