ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

A SUB-CHAPTER S CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

That the name of the corporation shall be: LAFAYETTE INC., a Sub-Chapter S Corporation.

ARTICLE II

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is as follows, to-wit:

(a) The primary purpose is to do all facets of business of all kinds which may be beneficial to the business including but not limited to the following.

(b) To purchase, sell, deal in homes, building materials, components of every kind, to buy, sell and deal in, hold, improve, subdivide and lease real estate, and to mortgage and encumber the same, and to erect, establish, manage, care for, and maintain, extend and alter residential, commercial, and other buildings, and to do all things necessary for or convenient thereunto.

(c) To act as broker, sales representative, sales agency, commission representative, factor, advisor and consultant for and to other concerns in similar or associated businesses in this State or elsewhere, and to do each and every or similar or related act in promoting the development and wider utilization of real estate, buildings, structures, and other similar businesses.

(d) To acquire, purchase, sell, mortgage, lease, encumber or otherwise dispose of such real and personal property as the corporation may desire, and the incidents thereunto convenient to the conduct of such corporation.

(e) To deal in mortgages, deeds of trust, bills, and notes, to hold, sell, trade, and manage real estate, and to deal and trade in all type of securities, interests, and property of every nature.

(f) Acquire and hold shares, debentures, bonds, obligations, securities and other instruments issued or granted by any company constituted or carrying on business in the United States, or in any colony or dependency or in any foreign country or granted by any government or public body, municipal, local or otherwise; and to deal in such investments and securities in all such companies or corporations and in this corporation.

(g) To carry on any business whatsoever which the corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with any of the foregoing purposes or otherwise, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the value of its property or business.

(h) To have and to exercise all the powers, conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations formed under the acts and pursuant to and under which this corporation is formed.

### ARTICLE III

The Corporation is to have perpetual existence as a Sub-Chapter S Corporation.

### ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation is: 6477 Fairview Avenue; Boise, Idaho 83704. Ernest L. Beckman.

### ARTICLE V

The total authorized number of shares is Five Thousand (5,000) Shares at the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share, all of which authorized capital stock shall be common stock, fully paid and

non-assessable. The aggregate par value is \$5,000.00.

ARTICLE VI

The president and secretary or vice president of the corporation shall and are authorized to execute deeds, mortgages, and other instruments relating to the sale, transfer, mortgaging, pledging and leasing of real and personal property.
