ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ROD CAYKO, who is over eighteen (18) years of age, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, adopts the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION for such Corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is ROD'S TRANSMISSION SERVICES, INC.

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.
