## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## DAVID LITTLE FARMS. INC.

-0-

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together, and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation, unite and associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho for the purposes hereinafter stated.

I.

The name of this corporation shall be "DAVID LITTLE FARMS, INC.".

II.

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

III.

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Emmett, Gem County, Idaho.

IV.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed and the general nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation are as follows:

a. To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire real and personal property of all kinds in the United States or elsewhere, and to sell, exchange, lease, mortgage, or otherwise deal

with the whole or any part of such property or rights; to cultivate and improve farms and agricultural lands; and generally to do anything or perform any act which, in the judgment of the directors or stockholders of the company, shall be necessary or proper and conducive to the best interests of said company in accomplishing any of the objects or purposes herein set out.

- b. To raise, grow, buy, sell and deal in and with sheep, cattle and all classes and descriptions of livestock, including all related by-products therefrom; to buy, sell, job or otherwise deal in, either at wholesale or retail, wool, meat, meat products, dairy products and edible foods of every kind and description; to pack, cure, render, refine and deal in meats and meat products and to manufacture, produce and generally deal in all articles made from the carcasses of animals; to establish, buy, lease or otherwise acquire, own, maintain, operate and dispose of all facilities and structures necessary or expedient for such purposes.
- c. To purchase or otherwise acquire letters patent, concessions, licenses, inventions, rights and privileges, subject to royalty or otherwise, and whether exclusive, nonexclusive, or limited, or any part interest in such letters patent, concessions, licenses, inventions, rights and privileges, whether in the United States of America, or in any other part of the world; to sell, let, or grant any patent rights, concessions, licenses, inventions, rights or privileges belonging to the company, or which it may acquire, or any interest in the same; to register any patent, or patents, for any invention, or inventions, or obtain exclusive or other privileges in respect to the same, in any part of the world, and to apply for, exercise, use, or otherwise deal with, or turn to account any patent rights, concessions, monopolies, or other rights or privileges, either in the United States or in any other part of the world.

- d. To purchase or otherwise acquire, lease, assign, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of any trade-names, trade-marks, concessions, inventions, formulae, improvements, processes of any nature whatsoever, either of the United States or of any foreign countries, and to accept and grant licenses thereunder.
- e. To subscribe or cause to be subscribed for, and to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold for investment, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange, distribute, or otherwise dispose of the whole or any part of the shares of the capital stock, bonds, coupons, mortgages, Deeds of Trust, debentures, securities, obligations, notes, and other evidences of indebtedness of any corporation, stock company, or association, now or hereafter existing, and whether created by or under the laws of the State of Idaho, or otherwise, and while owners of any such shares of the capital stock or bonds or other property to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership of every kind and description, including the right to vote thereon, with power to designate some person for that purpose from time to time, to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.
- f. To purchase, hold, sell and re-issue the shares of the stock of this corporation.
- g. To carry on and conduct any business whatsoever which the corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with the foregoing purposes, or otherwise, or which may be calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of this corporation, or to enhance the value of its property, and to hold, purchase, mortgage and convey real and personal property, either in or out of the State of Idaho, and to have and to exercise all the

powers conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations formed under the Act pursuant to and under which this corporation is formed. To purchase, or lease, hold, improve, sell, and convey such real estate, and to construct, lease and maintain thereon such buildings, warehouses, workshops, manufacturing plants, or other improvements, as shall be necessary or proper, in the judgment of the directors or stockholders, for conducting the business of this corporation, either within or without the State of Idaho. To borrow money and otherwise incur indebtedness, i. without limit as to amount, and to draw, make, accept, indorse, transfer, assign, guarantee, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, notes, drafts, bills of exchange, negotiable instruments, and all other evidence of indebtedness, negotiable or non-negotiable, whether secured or unsecured. j. For the purpose of securing all or any of its contracts, obligations, or liabilities, to convey, transfer, assign, deliver, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise hypothecate, all of or any part of the property or assets at any time held or owned by this corporation. To conduct its business and exercise all or any of its powers as above specified, or otherwise, in the State of Idaho, or in any other State, territory, or colony of the United States. the District of Columbia, or any other part of the world, as fully and to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, either alone, or in association with others, and at its option to have one or more offices or places of business outside the State of Idaho, and such offices or places of business as shall - 4 -

be determined by its Board of Directors within the State of Idaho, in addition to its registered and principal place of business as set out in these Articles.

1. It is the intention of the incorporators of this
Company that the foregoing clauses shall be construed both as
objects and powers and the foregoing enumeration of specific
objects and powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict
in any manner the powers of the corporation, but said corporation
shall have the power to do all and everything necessary, suitable,
convenient, or proper for the accomplishment of any of its
purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects
hereinabove emmerated, or incidental to the purposes and objects
hereinabove named, or which shall at any time appear conducive
or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation,
and which is permitted under the laws of the State of Idaho, under
which this corporation is organized, to the same extent and as
fully as a natural person might or could do.

**v**.

The business of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a board of at least three directors, the exact number thereof to be fixed as provided by the By-Laws, the first Board to be elected at the first meeting of the stock-holders of this corporation and the entire Board to be elected annually thereafter at the annual meeting of the stockholders of this corporation.

VI.

The Board of Directors of this corporation may meet and transact the business of this corporation either at the principal

place of business herein designated, or at such other place within or without the State of Idaho as may be designated by a majority of the Board of Directors.

VII.

This corporation shall have a total authorized capital stock of TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$250,000.00), divided into TWENTY FIVE THOUSAND (25,000) shares of the par value of TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) per share, Common Stock.

VIII.
