#### Article 1 Name

The name of this corporation shall be:

Idaho Falls Christian Academy, Inc.

#### Article 2 Purpose

The purpose of Idaho Falls Christian Academy is:

1. To train students in the knowledge of God and the Christian way of life.

2. To provide students with an unparalled education based on Biblical reasoning rather than humanistic beliefs.

3. To teach the Bible and applications to daily living.

4. To teach a quality program of academic subjects and electives. This includes a thorough knowledge of Bible, Mathematics, English, Science, and History.

5. To provide a quality Christian faculty who are knowledgeable in the subjects they teach.

6. To keep the Bible and the academic standards high to encourage each student to achieve their personal best for God.

7. To exemplify Christ in our classrooms by putting into practice the Bible lessons, and praying for each student.

8. To build the confidence and self esteem of each student by daily encouragement and praise mixed with constructive criticism and Christian love.

#### Article 5 Officers

I. The management and business affairs of Idaho Falls Christian Academy shall be conducted by a board of directors which shall consist of:

- 1. Chariman of Board
- 2. Administrator
- 3. School Board
- 4. Treasurer
- 5. Secretary

#### II. Qualification

1. Officers, using Biblical principals, must be a born again Christian. This is to have a testimony of the acceptance of Jesus Christ as the Savior depending only upon the finished work upon the cross for their salvation.

2. Officers must be active in the ministry of Jesus Christ demonstrated by faithful participation in a Christian institution.

3. No one shall serve as an officer that is involved in alcohol, tobacco, illegal drugs, a homosexual lifestyle, or rock music.

4. Officers must be in agreement with the doctrinal stand given in Article 3.

5. The Chairman of the Board must also meet the qualifications given in Article 7 (School Board) Section IV.

#### Article 6 Election/Dismissal of Officers

#### I. Election

1. Officer selection is only by the qualifications given in Article 4. Discrimination against age, race, gender, or physical disabilities will not be allowed.

2. The administrator and school board shall meet annually to elect or retain officers and appoint trustees.

#### II. Dismissal

1. Officers failing to meet any of the officer qualifications shall be dismissed.

#### Article 7 School Board

I. The Chairman of the board is voting member of the school board.

II. The administrator is a non-voting member of the school board.

III. Duties of the school board are:

- 1. To recruit and hire qualified teachers.
- 2. To dismiss teachers.
- 3. To establish the school budget.
- 4. To set the future direction of the School.
- 5. To maintain doctrinal integrity.
- 6. To establish policies and standards.

IV. Voting school board members must be the male head of their family, in leadership of the education of their children as required by God (Ephesians 6:4/Psalm 78:5.)

#### **Article 8 Teachers**

- I. Teacher qualifications are the same as officers.
- II. The school board is the authority over teachers.

#### **Article 9 Trustees**

I. Trustees qualifications are the same as officers.

II. The trustees are to be appointed by the school board.

III. To make budget recommendations to the school board.

IV. Duties of the trustees are:

- 1. To handle the financial matters for the school.
- 2. To maintain school facilities and property.

#### Article 10 Finances

I. Idaho Falls Christian Academy shall not issue stock and no dividend or pecuniary profit shall be declared or paid to the officers thereof. The corporation is to be considered not for profit. The annual budget will adjust tuition costs and teacher salaries to maintain this status.

1. Financial provision for Idaho Falls Christian Academy shall be by gifts, fund 🥠 raising, private grants and tuition.

2. All wages and tuition will be in the annual budget.

#### Article 11 Membership

Idaho Falls Christian Academy shall not have members.

#### **Article 12 Duration**

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

#### **Article 13 Dissolution**

Upon dissolution all assets of Idaho Falls Christian Academy shall be distributed by the stated officers to another organization that is in agreement with the purpose and doctrinal statement contained in articles II and III.
