

DESIGNATION OF AGENT, AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE PROVISIONS OF  
THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Utah Independent Telephone Company, a Corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah having filed in the Office of Secretary of State of the State of Idaho a duly othenticated copy of its articles of incorporation, does hereby in pursuance of the laws of the State of Idaho, make this certificate and does hereby designate Bannock County in the State of Idaho as the County in which the principal place of business of said Corporation in Said State of Idaho is and shall be conducted and does hereby designate F. S. Dietrich residing at Pocatello, in said Bannock County as the Authorized Agent of said Corporation in said State of Idaho, upon whom process issued by authority of or under any law of the State of Idaho, may be served as provided by the Constitution and laws of said state Of Idaho.

And the said Utah Independent Telephone Company desiring and intending to conform in all respects to the Constitution and Laws of said State and to avail itsself of the rights, priviliges and immunities guaranteed by said Constitution and laws does hereby accept the provision of the Constitution of the State of Idaho for ~~the~~ all the intents and purposes contemplated by the provisions thereof, relating to such acceptance by other than municipal Corporations (Article XI, Sec. 7 Constitution of Idaho)
