Purpose: To amend our articles of incorporation/constitution.  
We, the board members and trustees and all the members of the  
McCall Conservative Baptist Church have voted on September 8, 1974,  
to amend our constitution as follows:

**IX** The McCall Conservative Baptist Church is organized  
exclusively for religious purposes, including, for such  
purposes, the making of distributions to organizations  
that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3)  
of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

**X.** That in case of dissolution, all assets and property  
shall go to the Conservative Baptist Association of America  
instead of the Conservative Baptist Association of Idaho.  
In the event the above named beneficiary may not be quali-  
fied, or may not be in existence, we hereby designate the  
Conservative Baptist Foreign Mission Society as our alter-  
native beneficiary.

This is to certify that on September 8, 1974, by vote of the majority of a quorum of the members of McCall Conservative Baptist Church, the articles of incorporation were amended as follows:

1. The McCall Conservative Baptist Church is organized exclusively for religious purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

2. That in case of dissolution, all assets and property shall go to the Conservative Baptist Association of America instead of the Conservative Baptist Association of Idaho. In the event the above named beneficiary may not be qualified, or may not be in existence, we hereby designate the Conservative Baptist Foreign Mission Society as our alternative beneficiary.

This also certifies that public notice was given of the intention to amend the articles of incorporation, by publication in the Star-News newspaper for four consecutive weeks prior to the meeting, the newspaper article designating the meeting time, date, and place. Results of the meeting and vote are recorded in the minutes of the McCall Conservative Baptist Church.
