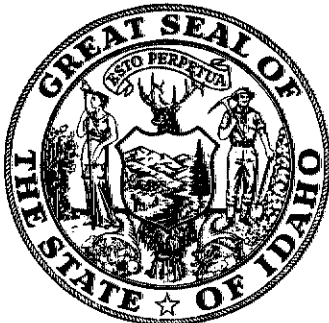

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:** That I, the undersigned, being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the General Corporation Laws of the State of Idaho and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

**ARTICLE I**

That the name of the corporation is Haul-A-Way, Inc.

**ARTICLE II**

The corporation is to have a perpetual existence.

**ARTICLE III**

The corporation is organized for any lawful purpose or purposes for which general business corporations may be organized under the laws of the State of Idaho.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

The corporation shall have authority to issue one thousand shares, of such shares to be of one (1) class of common stock with no par value, and to be issued in accordance with the provisions of Section 1244 of the Internal Revenue Code.

#### **ARTICLE V**

The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatsoever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business, or paying debts of the corporation.

#### **ARTICLE VI**

The number of directors of the corporation shall be as specified in the By-Laws, and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as may be prescribed in the By-Laws.

#### **ARTICLE VII**

Stockholders of the corporation shall have preemptive preferential rights of subscription to any shares of stock of the corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized, and any obligations issued by the corporation shall first be offered to the stockholders of the corporation.

### **ARTICLE VIII**

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be 531 Mesquite, Boise, Idaho 83713, and the name of the registered agent at such address shall be Jason S. Lind.

### **ARTICLE IX**

The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be two (2), and the names and addresses of the people who are to serve as directors until the first annual meeting of the shareholders, or until their successor or successors shall be elected and qualify shall be as follows:
