### ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BEAR LAKE COUNTY SHERIFF'S SEARCH AND RESCUE ASSOCIATION, INC.

THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is BEAR LAKE COUNTY SHERIFF'S SEARCH AND RESCUE ASSOCIATION. INC.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

FOURTH: This corporation is organized exclusively for the following purposes:

- (a) To assist the Bear Lake County Sheriff and other duly authorized law enforcement agencies in search and rescue.
- (b) To assist the Bear Lake County Sheriff at his special request in law enforcement.
- (c) To engage in activities which are aimed to educate and inform the general public in safety during hunting, hiking, travel and boating.
- (d) To engage in all such activities as are incident or conducive to the attainment of the purposes set forth herein and to do any and all such acts as any nonprofit organization may lawfully engage under the status of a corporation duly organized under Idaho Code 30-301, et seq.

FIFTH: In lieu of capital stock, the corporation shall issue membership certificates to representatives from the general public who meet the qualifications as further set forth in the By-Laws as duly adopted or hereafter amended.

SIXTH: No dividend shall be paid and no part of the income shall be distributed to members, directors or officers of the corporation. The corporation may compensate or reimburse its members, directors, officers or employees for reasonable expenditures.

This corporation shall use its funds only for the purposes stated in these Articles, and no part of the funds shall inure to the personal benefit of or be distributed to the members of the corporation or directors, except compensation, expense reimbursement or salaries to officers and employees.

In the event this corporation shall be dissolved, the net assets remaining shall be distributed to one or more qualified charitable, educational, scientific or public entity; providing that said entity meet the rules and regulations of the Internal Revenue Service for the United States and selection thereof shall be by the Board of Directors of the corporation.

SEVENTH: The members of the corporation shall not be personally liable for liabilities or obligations of the corporation.

EIGHTH: These Articles may be amended by two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the membership at any annual meeting or any special meeting appropriately called for such purpose.

TWELFTH: The method and manner of holding directors meetings and other corporate meetings, the authority and duties of each of the officers of the corporation and directors and all other matters for management or control of the corporation shall be determined by the By-Laws of the corporation and by the laws of the State of Idaho and shall not be inconsistent with the Articles of Incorporation as set forth herein.
