

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO
THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
POST FALLS CHAMBER OF COMMERCE, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 30-327 of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Articles of Amendments to its Articles of Incorporation:

First the name of the corporation is Post Falls Chamber of Commerce, Inc.

Second the following Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation were adopted by a majority vote of the members of the corporation present in person or by proxy, such members constituting a quorum at the meeting of the members on the 19th day of April, 1983, in the manner prescribed by the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

Article III of the original Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

ARTICLE III.

The principal office in the State of Idaho of this corporation is at Post Falls, County of Kootenai, Post Office Box Number 32.

Article VIII of the original Articles of Incorporation is amended to read as follows:

The number of directors of this corporation shall be fixed by the By-laws. The By-laws may provide that the directors which are elected may be divided into classes and that the election of said classes may be staggered such that not all directors are elected in any one year. Ex officio and honorary directors may be appointed as provided in the By-laws.
