CORPORATION REINSTATEMENT CERTIFICATE

I, PETE T. GENARRUSA
ARNOLD WILLIAMS Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State and collector of the annual corporation tax, do hereby certify that

THE FRIENDS CHURCH OF BOISE

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho with its principal place of business in Idaho located at Boise, Idaho, forfeited on the 2nd day of December, 1968, its charter or authority to do business in the State of Idaho, because of failure to file an annual statement due the State of Idaho for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 1969, as provided by Section 30-608, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY That the said corporation has subsequently and on the 22nd day of August, 1969, filed an annual statement and the said corporation is therefore reinstated on the records of this office, and all the corporate rights which it enjoyed under the Constitution and Laws of the State of Idaho prior to the date of said forfeiture, are hereby restored.

Articles of Incorporation,

Friends Church of Boise, Idaho.

KNOW ALL MEN :-

That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, a religious corporation to be known as the Friends Church of Boise.

And we certify :-

1.

The name assumed by this corporation, and by which it shall be known, is : The Friends Church of Boise.

II.

The object for which this corporation is formed, is -

To establish a Church in the City of Boise, in the County of Ada and State of Idaho for the benefit of religion, for works of charity, and for public worship, and in connection therewith, its suitable and customary organizations, such as Sabbath Schools, Christian Endeavors, and so forth - To take charge of the Church and Church Parsonage, and all and singular, the estate, property, and the affairs of the temporalities thereof - and To acquire, hold, lease, contract, sell, convey and dispose of said property, or any part thereof.

III.

The estimated value of the property at the time of making these articles of incorporation is two thousand dollars.

IV.

The number of trustees who shall have management of this corporation shall be five, and the names and residences of the trustees elected for the first year, are : -

That the said trustees were duly elected at the regular Monthly Meeting of the members of the Friends Church of Boise, duly convened and held at the house of J. D. Emerick, on Tenth Street, in Boise, Ada County, Idaho, for the purpose, among other things, of electing trustees to take charge and management of its property, temporalities, and affairs, and to form this incorporation. That a majority of said members were then and there present, and voted at such election, for the above named trustees, as is more particularly set out in the certificate and verification by the Officers who conducted the election, hereto annexed and made part of these articles.

VI.

All deeds, leases, and other instruments in writing shall be signed by the President and Secretary of the TRUSTEES of the said Friends Church of Boise, and sealed with the seal of the corporation, - PROVIDED, - Said deeds, leases, and other instruments in writing shall be first authorized in the usual way by resolution duly passed at a regular Monthly Meeting, of the Society.
