THESE PRESENTS WITNESS, That we, A.H.Averill, M.B.McFaul and G.O.Graves of Portland, Oregon, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purpose hereinafter specified and in conformity to the laws of the State of Oregon, do make and subscribe the following Articles of Incorporation, in triplicate:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be THE A.H.AVERILL MACHINERY CO.

ARTICLE II.

The object for which this corporation is formed is and shall be, dealing in machinery for agricultural and other purposes, and supplies for same.

ARTICLE III.

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) divided into shares of One Hundred Dollars each.

ARTICLE IV.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be located in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon.
