I, LOUIS E. CLAPP, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that

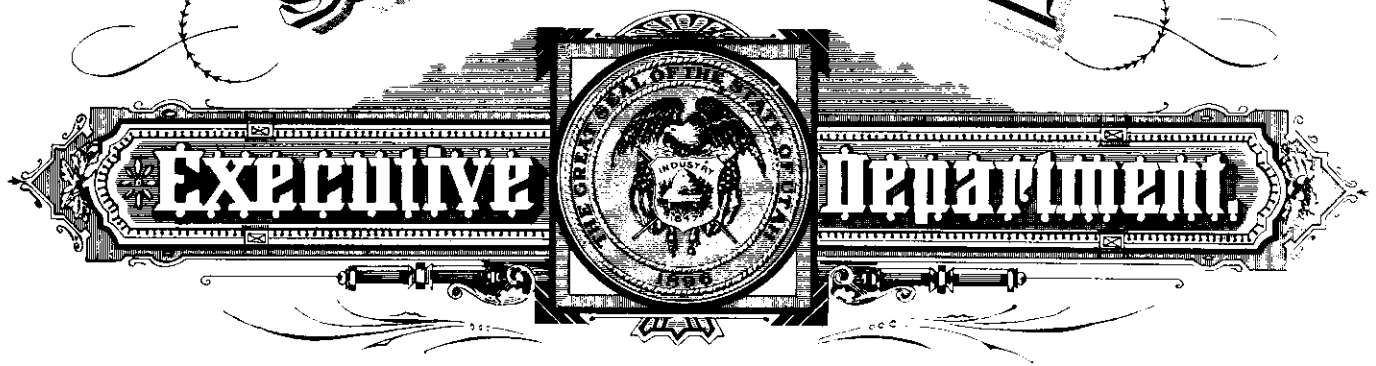

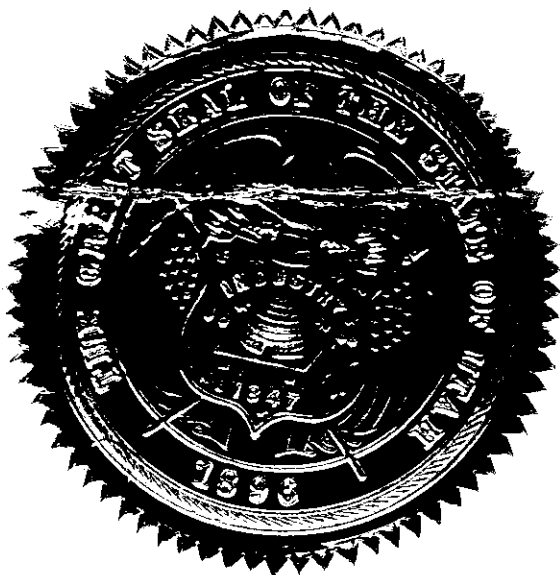

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

1966 OCT 10 AM 10 50

We, the undersigned, natural persons of the age of 21 years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Utah Business Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST

The name of the corporation is WESTERN HY-SI SALES, INC.

SECOND

The period of its duration is perpetual or until terminated by law.

THIRD

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

To establish, maintain and conduct a general business in farm product preservatives, feed, and agricultural products of any nature and for all purposes, including the purchase, sale, and dealing in the same in any manner, and to engage in any lawful activity, whether in connection with the foregoing or not, calculated to benefit the corporation.

FOURTH

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation is authorized to issue is 20,000 shares with a par value of \$1.00 per share.

FIFTH

The corporation will not commence business until consideration of the value of at least \$1,000.00 has been received from the issuance of shares.

SIXTH

There shall be no pre-emptive rights to acquire shares in this corporation.

SEVENTH

The post office address of its initial registered office

is RFD 1, Box 79, Spanish Fork, Utah. The registered agent is  
Ralph A. Henderson.

EIGHTH

The Board of Directors shall consist of such number, not less  
than three, as shall be fixed from time to time in the By-Laws.
