Name of Corporation Modern Mining Company Inc.

Article Amended:

7. Authorized shares. The total number of shares which the Corporation shall have the authority to issue is 5,000,000 with a value of 1/10 of a cent, which shall be classified as common shares.

Date of adoption: April 16, 1989.

On this date 2,515,000 shares were outstanding and entitled to vote.

2,415,000 shares were voted in favor of the amendment, and 0 (zero) shares were voted against adopting the amendment.

All no par value shares will be redeemed and exchanged on a one for one basis for shares having a par value of 1/10 of cent.
