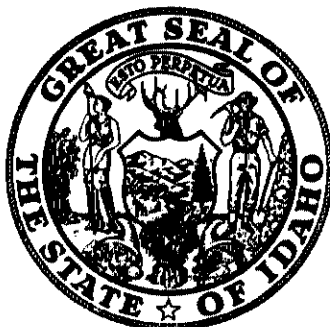
CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF

**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
BONNER COUNTY HUMAN RIGHTS TASK FORCE, INC.**

The undersigned, acting as incorporators under the Idaho Non Profit Corporation Act Title 30, Chapter 3, hereby adopt these Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be Bonner County Human Rights Task Force, Incorporated.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSE

The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including such purposes the receipt of contributions within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. To further these purposes, the Corporation shall provide educational information in furtherance to positive human relations in the Bonner County community relative to discouraging harassment and bigotry toward people because of their racial, religious, national origin or sexual orientation.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have only one class of members. Management of the affairs of the Bonner County Human Rights Task Force(BCHRTF) is vested in its members pursuant to Section 30-314 of the Idaho Code. Members shall be accepted after being interviewed by a membership committee appointed by the officers. New members must agree to uphold the principles and purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Founding members will elect the Board of Directors, who will appoint officers to manage the affairs of the Corporation until elections are held by the General Membership. The Board of Directors will adopt the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V - LIMITATIONS OF ACTIONS

No part of the funds of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, nor be distributable to, its officers or directors, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the activities shall be the carrying on of the propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in any political campaign of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under S 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE VI - DURATION

The duration of the Corporation shall be perpetual. Upon the winding up and dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for paying all of the debts and obligations of the Corporation, distribute the remaining assets of the Corporation to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation which has established its tax exempt status under S 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
