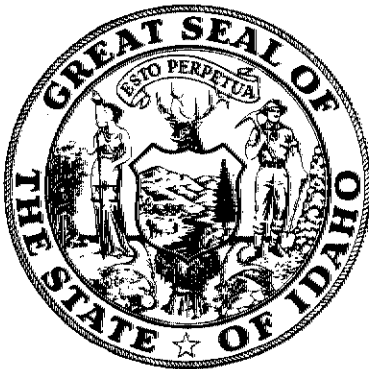

PURPOSES

To manufacture, produce, buy, sell, import, export, either at wholesale or retail, or both, repair, improve, lease, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise deal with and in all types of goods, wares, merchandise, commodities, and other property, including, but not by way of limitation, beers, near-beers, ales, porters, stouts, malts, yeasts, sugars, wines and other vinous products, distilled spirits, alcohols, alcoholic and non-alcoholic liquors, soft drinks, juices, extracts, bottled and other waters, syrups, grains, food, feeds, containers, medicinal and pharmaceutical preparations, chemicals, gases, liquids, vehicles, railroad cars, boats, air-planes, tractors, trailers, appliances, machinery, implements and equipment of all kinds and descriptions, and all ingredients, parts, accessories, by-products, devices, and processes associated with any of the foregoing.

To operate, promote and conduct exhibitions, sporting events, amusements and entertainments; and more especially, but not by way of limitation, to purchase, acquire, sell, lease, develop, own, manage and control amusement, recreational, and entertainment facilities, gardens, theaters, athletic fields, stadiums, arenas, athletic clubs and other organizations engaged in such activities.

To breed, lease, rent, buy, sell, either at wholesale or retail, or both, import, export, exhibit or otherwise deal in animals, including, but not by way of limitation, mammals, fish, birds and reptiles of every kind or species.

To purchase, lease, exchange, or otherwise acquire improved or unimproved real estate wherever situated, and any interest therein; to own, hold, control, maintain, manage, subdivide, plat, use and develop the same; to erect, construct, maintain, improve, rebuild, enlarge, alter, manage, operate and control buildings, houses, barns, stables, hotels, motels, apartments, stores, offices, warehouses, mills, shops, factories, grain or liquid storage facilities, machinery and plants, and all structures of every kind and description on any lands, owned, held or leased by the corporation, or upon any other lands; to lease or sublease offices, stores, houses, apartments, and other buildings or structures, and to sell, lease, sublease, mortgage, exchange, assign, transfer, convey, pledge, or otherwise alienate or dispose of any of such real estate and property, or any interest therein.

To purchase, take, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, employ, sell, transfer, assign, mortgage, loan, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, and otherwise use and deal in and with, all types of shares of stock or other interests in, or obligations of, other domestic or foreign corporations, associations, partnerships, or individuals, or direct or indirect obligations of the United States or of any other government, state, territory, governmental district or municipality or of any instrumentality thereof.

To purchase, acquire, sell, lease, develop, own, manage, contract, or otherwise carry on, to the extent permitted by applicable law, transportation and service facilities, businesses, and operations, including, but not by way of limitation, trucking lines, parking lots, garages, bars, restaurants, lodges and resorts.

To do everything necessary, proper, advisable or convenient, in the United States or elsewhere, for the accomplishment or attainment of any of the purposes herein set forth, either alone or associated with others, and incidental or pertaining to, or growing out of, or connected with, its business.

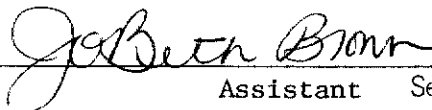
