OPTIONAL (Delete Article VI if not applicable.)

When a compromise or arrangement or a plan of reorganization of this corporation is proposed between this corporation and its creditors or any class of them or between this corporation and its shareholders or any class of them, a court of equity jurisdiction within the state, on application of this corporation or of a creditor or shareholder thereof, or on application of a receiver appointed for the corporation, may order a meeting of the creditors or class of creditors or of the shareholders or class of shareholders to be affected by the proposed compromise or arrangement or reorganization, to be summoned in such manner as the court directs. INFORMATION AND INSTRUCTIONS

Articles of Incorporation -- Profit Domestic Corporations

- 1 Article 1-The corporate name of a domestic profit consoration is required to contain one of the following words to abbreviations: "Corporation", "Company", "Incorporated", "Limited", "Corp.", "Co.", "Inc." or "Ltd."
- 2. Article II may state, in general terms, the chiracter of the particular business to be carried on. Under section 202 his of the law, it is a sofficient compliance to state substantially, after or with specifically suggested under the theorems corporation may engage in any activity within the purposes for which corporations may be organized under the this mean Corporation Act. The law requires, however, that educational corporations must state their specific.
- Article III The law requires the incorporators of a domestic corporation having there's without per value to submit in teriting the amount of consideration proposed to be received for each share which shall be allocated to stated capital.
- 4. Article V : The law requires one or more incorporators.

- 5. The duration of the corporation should be stated in the Articles only if the duration is not perpetual.
- The Articles must be signed in link by each incorporator. The names of the incorporators as set out in Article Schoold correspond with the signatures.
- 7. One original copy of the Articles is required A true copy will be prepared by the Corporation and Securities Bureau and returned to the person submitting the Articles for filing.
- 8. An effective date, not later than 90 days affisequent to the date of filing, may be stated in the Articles of Incorporation
- 9 FEES. Filing Fee. Franchise Fee. 8 mill on each dollar of authorized capital stock, with a nuninum franchise fee of (Make fee payable to State of Michigan).
