

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That the undersigned, being a majority of the Board of Directors of the Idaho Service Company, do hereby certify and declare;

1. That by a majority vote of the Stockholders of the Idaho Service Company, a meeting of the Stockholders thereof, was called for the purpose of diminishing the capital stock of said corporation;

2. That personal notice of the time and place of such meeting and the object thereof, was served on each Stockholder at least thirty day's prior to the date of such proposed meeting;

3. That the notice contained the amount to which it was proposed to diminish the capital stock;

4. That it was not proposed to diminish the capital stock to an amount less than the indebtedness of the corporation;

5. That at a meeting of the Stockholders convened at Jerome, Idaho, on the 17th day of December 1918, pursuant to the notice hereinbefore set forth, twenty three shares of the capital stock of said corporation, being all of the outstanding shares, were represented and voted unanimously to diminish the said capital stock from One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) the present authorized capital stock to Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) divided into one hundred shares of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) each.
