

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
MALAD UNDERTAKING AND FUNERAL SERVICE COMPANY, LIMITED

BE IT KNOWN That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho

And We Heroby Certify:

First. That the name of this corporation is

Malad Undertaking and Funeral Service Company, Limited

Second. That the purposes for which it is formed are to engage in, transact and carry on a general undertaking business, including the embalming of bodies of persons deceased, and the directing and conduct of funerals of deceased persons. To buy and sell caskets and all other funeral supplies of every kind and character sufficient and necessary to supply the local trade and business of the community, including embalming fluids and materials and embalming apparatus. To buy, acquire, obtain, own, hold, improve, manage, invest in, sell, convey, transfer, lease, rent and dispose of any and all real estate and personal property as the purposes of the corporation may require and reasonably necessary to the transaction of its business. To acquire the good will, property, rights, assets, and stock of any person, firm, association or corporation, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, bonds, or otherwise. And to do any and all acts and things incidental to, necessary, convenient or proper to be done to completely attain the objects herein mentioned

Third. That the place where its principal place of business is to be transacted shall be Malad, Oneida County, State of Idaho

Fourth. That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation

Fifth. That the number of its directors shall be four, and the names of those appointed for the first year and until the election and qualification of their successors shall be Daniel W. Woodland,

Veuriam Dives, J. Guy Benson, and Thomas Dives.

Sixth . That the officers of the corporation shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and the names of the officers selected for the first year and until the qualification of their successors are: Daniel P. Woodland, President; Veuriam Dives, Vice-President, Thomas Dives, Secretary, and J. Guy Benson, Treasurer

Seventh. That the amount of its capital stock shall be ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), divided into one hundred shares (100) of the par value of \$100.00 each

Eighth. That the amount of said capital stock which has been actually subscribed is \$5,000.00, and the following are the names of the persons by whom the same has been subscribed, to-wit:

Ninth. That the private property of the stockholders of this corporation shall not be liable for the debts or liabilities of the corporation
