I, IRA H. MASTERS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

GRACE LUTHERAN CHURCH, INC., OF POTLATCH, IDAHO.

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **13th** day of **June** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-three** and is duly recorded on Film No. **41** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Potlatch** in the County of **Latah**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of the
GRACE LUTHERAN CHURCH, Inc., OF POTLATCH, IDAHO

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That We, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, having associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

I

That the name of the corporation is and shall be THE GRACE LUTHERAN CHURCH, Inc., of POTLATCH, IDAHO.

II

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.

III

The location and principal office of this corporation shall be in Potlatch, County of Latah, State of Idaho.

IV

The purpose for which said corporation is organized and incorporated is and shall be:

- (1) To establish and maintain a place of Divine Worship.
- (2) To preach and teach the full gospel and to promulgate the established doctrines of the Christian religion and conduct sacred rites of the church not only in the principal place of said corporation but in such other cities and places within and without the state of Idaho, as may be determined by said corporation.
- (3) To establish, maintain, conduct such departments, occupations and enterprises as may be deemed necessary or advisable to the furtherance of the above mentioned purposes.

- (4) To purchase, lease, acquire, accept, hold and manage by deed, grant, will, gift, bequest, trust or otherwise all manner and kinds of property whether real personal or mixed to be used for and carry out the purposes for which said corporation was organized.
- (5) To sell, borrow, mortgage, issue its notes, bonds, debentures and other evidences of indebtedness and to do any and every act or thing germane to any of the aforesaid purposes.
- (6) Pecuniary profit shall not be the object or purpose of this corporation.

V

The estimated value of the property and money possessed by this corporation at the time of executing these articles of incorporation within the state of Idaho and vested in said corporation is THIRTY FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS. The sources of revenue or income in this corporation is and will be pledges, gifts, bequests, offerings and contributions and money derived from the property of the corporation.

VI

Two publications were made of notice of incorporation and election of directors of the GRACE LUTHERAN CHURCH OF POTLATCH, IDA.

Said notice was placed in the Daily Idahonian, Newspaper of general circulation for Moscow, Latah County, Idaho, on 28th day of May, 1953, and the 4th day of June, 1953, two weeks prior to the scheduled meeting of its members, by said Newspaper, the Daily Idahonian.

For two weeks prior to meeting, a notice setting forth like information was posted in a conspicuous place on the building where election of directors and plans for organization were made.

Said meeting was duly held on Sunday, the 7th day of June, 1953, with a majority of members present, the Articles of Incorporation were read and adopted. Election of Directors was held.
