ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
LACLEDE COMMUNITY SUNDAY SCHOOL, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, do hereby associate ourselves together to form a non-profit corporation under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is "LACLEDE COMMUNITY SUNDAY SCHOOL, INC."

ARTICLE II

The principal office of said corporation for the transaction of business shall be at Laclede, Bonner County, Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed are:

1. To construct, maintain and own a building for the purpose of providing a Sunday School and activities of religious worship in the community of Laclede, Idaho.
2. To sponsor, promote, coordinate and assist in charitable and religious endeavors in the community of Laclede, Idaho, and to provide a church school and house of worship at Laclede, Idaho.
3. To enter into any and all contracts that may become necessary for the carrying out of the purposes aforesaid.
4. To own real and personal property and to enter into leases and agreements and to buy, sell, convey or acquire real or personal property.
5. To contract debts and issue notes and other evidence of said indebtedness.
6. To do and perform and engage in any and all agreements, contracts, franchises as may, by Idaho Law, be permitted to be done and performed by non-profit corporations, including the right and privilege of making gifts and donations to charitable

endeavors and persons in need.

#### ARTICLE IV

The period of existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### ARTICLE V

The government and business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by a Board of not less than five (5) members, to be elected from time to time, as fixed by the By-laws of the corporation. The directors, to act until their successors are elected and qualified, shall be:

#### ARTICLE VI

The corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and has no capital stock.

#### ARTICLE VII

The membership of this corporation shall consist of the signatories to these Articles and such persons as may from time to time pay the required membership fee as may be set by the Board of Directors in compliance with the requirements of the By-Laws of the corporation. A certificate of membership shall be issued to each member thereof, which certificate cannot be assigned so that the transferee can, by such transfer, become a member of the corporation except upon resolution of the Board of Directors and under such regulations as the By-Laws prescribe. The By-Laws of the corporation shall provide the qualification of members and the terms and conditions of admission.

#### ARTICLE VIII

No member shall have or acquire any right, title, or interest in any of the earnings or accumulations of the corporation or its property. The right and interest of all members shall be equal and each shall have equal voice and right at all meetings of members and have the right to equal privileges upon
