## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

H. D. OZBURN AND SONS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

We, the undersigned, each being at least twenty-one years of age and residents of the State of Idaho and citizens of the United States, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated do, under and by virtue of the general laws of the State of Idaho authorizing the formation of corporations, associate ourselves as incorporators with the intention of forming a corporation, and do hereby certify as follows:

The name of the corporation shall be:

H. D. OZBURN AND SONS, INC.

The purposes for which this corporation are formed are:

- (a) To engage in the business of farming and ranching.
- (b) To own, hold, and to acquire for use certificates of convenience of necessity, licenses, and franchises from state, city, county or federal agencies as required in the furtherance of the corporation's business.
- (c) To lease, buy, sell, use, mortgage, improve or otherwise own, operate, handle, deal in, or dispose of such property as vehicles, equipment, or any other property, real or personal, as may be necessary, convenient or useful in connection with the business of the corporation.
- (d) In general, to carry on any other lawful business whatsoever in connection with the foregoing or which is calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interest of the corporation and to enhance the form of its properties and to do all other things necessary for the protection of the benefit of the corporation.

The corporation is to have perpetual existence.
