

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS. That we, the undersigned members and trustees of Meridian Lodge No 6664, Modern Woodmen of America, pursuant to instructions given to us by said Lodge, at a regular meeting of said Lodge, held in their hall at Meridian, Ada County, Idaho, on the First day of October, in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred and one, do hereby form said Lodge into a corporation according to, and under the laws of the State of Idaho.

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY:

FIRST: That the name of said Corporation is Meridian Lodge No. 6664, Modern Woodmen of America.

SECOND: That the purposes for which it is formed are to purchase, receive, hold, sell and convey such real or personal property, as said Lodge may require or use, for the purpose of carrying out the benevolent or other objects of said Lodge, according to the constitution, by-laws, rules and regulations of said Lodge, or other lodges to which it may be subject, and for the encouragement of the growth and spread of fraternalism and benevolence.

THIRD:- That the place where its principal place of business is to be transacted is the Town of Meridian, County of Ada, and State of Idaho.

FOURTH:- That the term for which it is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

FIFTH:- That the number of its Trustees shall be five, and that the names and residences of those who have been elected for the first year are:
