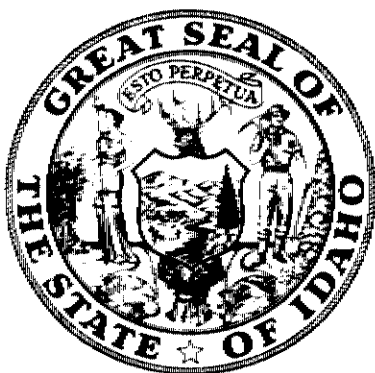

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

HOME AWAY FROM HOME, INC.

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The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is HOME AWAY FROM HOME, INC.

SECOND: The corporation is a nonprofit corporation.

THIRD: The period of its duration is perpetual.

FOURTH: This corporation is organized for the following purposes:

A. To establish and maintain a system and network of residence facilities for the care, shelter, training and advancement of mentally handicapped adults, including one or more shelter homes, semi-independent and independent housing; to provide a program of personal and living skills training for resident handicapped adults, as well as limited job skills training; to provide for the basic food, shelter, recreation and social needs of resident handicapped adults.

B. To engage in any activity incidental or necessary to the attainment of the purposes of this corporation.

C. To engage in any or all lawful purposes for which a corporation may be incorporated under the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act.

This corporation is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by any organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

FIFTH: The corporation shall have members with eligibility requirements and rights of membership as set forth in the Bylaws.

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SIXTH: The location of the initial registered office of the corporation is 1709 Spaulding, Boise, ID 38705, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Lillian B. Hall.

SEVENTH: The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be no less than three (3) and no more than fifteen (15), and the names and addresses of the persons who are to serve until the first annual meeting of the members and until their successors are elected and qualified are:

NINTH: The Board of Directors is expressly authorized to alter, amend, and repeal the Bylaws of the corporation and to adopt new Bylaws, subject to repeal or change by a majority vote of the members.

TENTH: Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the organization, the remaining

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assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
