

Certificate of Incorporation

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
UNDER THE
GENERAL NOT FOR PROFIT CORPORATION ACT

To THE SECRETARY OF STATE
Jefferson City, Missouri:

We, the undersigned,

Francis M. O'Brien	706 Chestnut Street	St. Louis, 1, Missouri
Webe H. Naunheim	2415 Woodson Road	Overland, 14, Missouri
Leland D. Carmack	9476 Olive Street Road	St. Louis, 32, Missouri

being natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more and citizens of the United States, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the "General Not For Profit Corporation Act" of the State of Missouri, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

1. The name of the corporation is: WORLD CLOTHING FUND, INCORPORATED.
2. The period of duration of the corporation is: Perpetual.
3. The address of its initial registered office in the State of Missouri is: 10500 Kahlmeyer Drive, St. Louis County, 32, Missouri, and the name of its initial registered agent at said address is: Leland D. Carmack.
4. The first Board of Directors shall be three (3) in number, their names and addresses being as follows:

5. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, literary and educational, including:

(A) To solicit and receive voluntary contributions throughout the world, and transmit such funds either the principal or income therefrom for relief of and or rehabilitation of needy, poor, handicapped or indigent people of the world or in any way to raise funds to be used throughout the world for the purpose of relief and or rehabilitation of needy, poor, handicapped or indigent people of the world.

(B) To gather, collect and receive clothing and all kinds of articles of value and to send the same for the purpose of relief and or rehabilitation of needy, poor, handicapped, or indigent people of the world.

(C) To furnish employment and occupational training to handicapped people of the world.

(D) To cooperate with and assist responsible welfare institutions, agencies and organizations in the caring for or rehabilitation of needy, poor, handicapped, or indigent people of the world.

6. The powers of the corporation are: Exclusively charitable, literary and educational, including the solicitation and use of contributions for the relief and or rehabilitation of needy, poor or handicapped people throughout the world; the collection of clothing and other articles of value for the relief or rehabilitation of people of the world; the furnishing of employment and occupational training to the handicapped people of the world; and to cooperate with responsible welfare agencies and organizations in caring for or rehabilitating the needy, poor, handicapped or indigent people of the world, and, in general to exercise any, all and every power which a non-profit corporation organized under the "General Not for Profit Corporation Act" of Missouri may exercise.

No part of the activities of this corporation shall include the carrying on of propaganda or the attempting to influence legislation. No part of the earnings or assets of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of any member thereof, contributor thereto, or any private, personal or selfish purpose. No part of the assets of this corporation or income derived therefrom shall be given to the benefit of any person, corporation or organization not tax exempt under Subtitle A of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America. No part of the income or property of the corporation may be loaned, without the receipt of adequate security and a reasonable rate of interest, to; no compensation, in excess of a reasonable allowance for salaries or other compensation for personal services actually rendered, may be paid to; no part of the services of the corporation may be made available on a preferential basis to; no substantial purchase of securities or any other property, for more than adequate consideration in money or money's worth, may be made from; no substantial part of the corporation's securities or other property, for less than an adequate consideration in money or money's worth, may be made to; nor may the corporation engage in any other transaction which results in a substantial diversion of its income or corporate to: --- any person who has made a substantial contribution to the corporation, any member of the family of an individual who has made a substantial

contribution to the corporation, or another corporation controlled by such person through the ownership, directly or indirectly, of 50% or more of the total combined voting power of all classes of stock entitled to vote or 50% or more of the total value of shares of all classes of stock thereof. The corporation is to be financed by contributions of funds and property absolutely and in trust for its purposes herein stated and for no other purposes. In event of dissolution of this corporation, none of its property shall be distributed to any person, corporation or organization not exempt under Subtitle A of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States of America, and all of its property shall be distributed at such time solely for the purposes set forth in Article 5 hereof. All officers of the corporation shall be ex officio members of the Board.

7. The Board of Directors may repeal or amend the bylaws of this corporation and may adopt new or additional bylaws.


