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Articles of Incorporation (Non-Profit) Continued.

Kamiah Valley Broadcasting Corporation

Article 8: Distribution of Assets.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational (religious) purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational (religious) purposes and has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

- Article 9:
- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes with the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
 - B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.
