### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**EMMANUEL BAPTIST CHURCH OF BLACKFOOT, IDAHO, INCORPORATED**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Thirteenth** day of **August,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-two** and is duly recorded on Film No. **120** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 30-103, 30-1101 and 30-1102, Idaho Code.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **Fifty years** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Blackfoot** in the County of **Bingham** and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 30, Idaho Code.

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating a religious corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, we certify:

### I

That said religious corporation is to be known as the EMMANUEL BAPTIST CHURCH OF BLACKFOOT, IDAHO, INCORPORATED..

### II

That the objects for which this corporation is formed are to establish and maintain a church in the City of Blackfoot, Bingham County, Idaho, and in connection therewith to acquire and own a church building, a parsonage, and any other necessary property and buildings suitable and customary for the purpose of holding public worship and religious training, co-operating on a voluntary basis with the program of the Southern Baptist Convention, and for the transaction of business, ten per cent of the active roll of members shall constitute a quorum, except that for the election of officers, fifteen per cent shall be present to constitute a quorum, and for any transaction pertaining to construction or use of buildings or property and the calling of a pastor, twenty per cent shall constitute a quorum, and the majority vote of the quorum shall be binding on the church body.

### III

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be at Blackfoot in the County of Bingham and State of Idaho.

### IV

That the term for which this corporation is to exist is fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

### V

That the number of trustees who shall have the management of the property and business affairs of said corporation as aforesaid, shall be, and the names of the incorporators and trustees elected for the first

year, are:

That said trustees were duly elected at a meeting of the members of said Church duly convened and held at Blackfoot, Bingham County, Idaho, on the 6th day of June, 1962, for the purpose of incorporating and acquiring and taking charge and management of property to be used in the furtherance of the objects of said religious corporation as herein set forth.

VII

That a majority of said members were then and there present and voted at such meeting wherein the above named trustees were elected, as is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification by the officers who conducted the election, a copy of which is annexed hereto and made a part of these articles.

CERTIFICATE AND VERIFICATION
