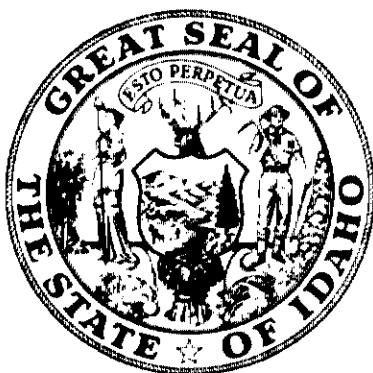

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

I

The name of said corporation shall be, Blackfoot Saddlemen's Association, Inc.

II

Said corporation is a non-profit organization of perpetual duration.

III

The purposes of this association are:

- a. To provide pleasure and recreation
- b. To promote cooperation and sportsmanship among riding organizations
- c. To encourage better horsemanship, care and use of horses
- d. Encourage community involvement to further a positive image of equestrian groups

IV

This corporation will be composed of members whose qualifications and rights are set forth in the bylaws. Assessments (e.g. dues) may be levied on members as recommended by the Board of Directors.

V

Management of the corporation is vested in its members. Elected officers and a Board of Directors have limited authority as defined in the bylaws. Decisions of the officers and Directors can be overridden by a majority (quorum) vote of the general membership.

VI

There will be an annual meeting of the general membership, in September of each year, to conduct scheduled elections, and finalize data for the corporations annual report. Other meetings will be as directed in the bylaws. Written notice of meetings is not required, except as prescribed by the bylaws.

VII

Every member in good standing, as defined in the bylaws, is entitled to one (1) vote on organizational issues.

Exceptions are:

- a. Only riding members shall have a vote on riding, horse, tack, and event apparel issues.
- b. Honorary members have no vote, however, they are encouraged to participate in discussion of issues

VIII

Complete and correct records of account, and minutes of all meetings shall be maintained in the corporations bound books for at least five (5) years. A copy of each annual report will be kept with the Articles of Incorporation, and the alphabetical listing of members, at the registered office until dissolution of the corporation.

IX

Issues not addressed in the Articles of Incorporation, or the bylaws, will be in accordance with the latest revision of the "Corporate Laws of the State of Idaho".
