

# ARTICLE IX.

The nature of the business of this corporation and the objects or purposes to be transacted, promoted or carried on by it are as follows:

Dection 1. To engage in the business of selling, constructing and erecting buildings and structures of all character, and to carry on any trade or business incident thereto or connected therewith.

Section 2. To purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, own, improve, utilize, lease, mortgage, pledge, sell, convey, and otherwise acquire, use, dispose of, encumber, or deal in both real and personal property of every kind and description.

dection i. To acquire by purchase, subscription, contract, or otherwise, and to hold for investment or otherwise, sell, exchange, mortgage, pledge, or otherwise dispose of, or turn to account, or realize upon, and generally to deal in and with all forms of securities, and to issue in exchange therefor or in payment thereof in any manner permitted by law its own stocks, bonds, debentures, or its other obligations or securities, or to make payment thereof by any other lawful means of payment whatsoever; to exercise any and all rights, powers, and privileges of individual

ownership or interest in respect of any and all such securities or evidences of interest therein, including the right to vote thereon, and to consent and otherwise act with respect thereto; to do any and all acts, or things for the preservation, protection, improvement, and enchancement in value of any and all such securities or evidences of interest therein.

Section 4. To borrow or raise money to any amount permitted by

Section 4. To borrow or raise money to any amount permitted by the general corporation laws of the State of Washington by the sale or issue of bonds, notes, debentures, collaterial trust certificates, or other obligations of any nature or in any manner, and to secure the same by mortgage or other liens upon any and all of the property, real, personal, or chose in action, of every description whatsoever, or any portion thereof, of the corporation.

Jection 5. To purchase, hold, cancel, reissue, sell or transfer snares of its own capital stock, provided that it shall not purchase shares of its own capital stock when such purchase would cause any impairment of its capital, and further, that shares of its own capital stock belonging to it directly or indirectly shall not be voted upon.

Section 6. To do, in the State of washington, or in any other country, state, territory, or locality, either as principal or agent and either alone or in connection with other corporations, firms, or individuals, all and everything necessary, suitable, convenient, or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated or incidental to the powers herein specified, or which shall at any time appear conducive to or expedient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes or attainment of any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Sashington, and to execute from time to time such general or special powers of attorney, and to such persons as the Board of Directors may approve, granting to such persons all powers, either in the United States or in any other country, state, territory, or locality which the Board of Directors may deem proper, and to revoke such powers of attorney as and when the Board of Directors may desire.

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It is the intention that the objects and purposes set forth in the foregoing clauses shall not, unless otherwise specified herein, be in any wise limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any clause of these Articles of Incorporation, but that the objects and purposes specified in each of said clauses shall be regarded as independent objects and purposes.

It is also the intention that the foregoing clauses shall be construed as powers, as well as objects and purposes, and that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation, and generally the corporation shall be authorized to exercise and enjoy all other powers, rights, and privileges granted by the laws of the State of Mashington.
