

Articles of Incorporation of the Harrison Canal and Irrigation Company.

Article. 1. This is to certify that we the undersigned residents and free holders of the County of Bingham and State of Idaho, have this day formed an organization, which shall be known and named the Harrison Canal and Irrigation Company.

Article. 2. The object for which this corporation is formed, is to take the waters of the South Fork of Snake River in Bingham County, Idaho, and carry the same by canals and lateral ditches to and upon the lands of Snake River Valley, for the purpose of irrigation, milling and mining, *and for the purpose of disposing of same for irrigation, milling and mining* and other purposes; and for the purpose of buying, claiming and holding real estate, so far as may be necessary for the purposes of the corporation, and to sell and convey the same.

Article. 3. The principal place of business of this corporation shall be at the Church House in school district No. 31 in Bingham County, State of Idaho, and where the office of the Company shall be kept.

Article. 4. The term for which this corporation shall exist, is fifty years.

Article. 5. The corporate stock of this corporation shall be Ten Thousand Dollars, divided into Two Thousand Shares at Five Dollars, each.

Article. 6. The number of Trustees of this corporation shall be five, and the names and residences of the Trustees, who shall manage the business of the company for the first year are as follows:

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF THE

HARRISON CANAL COMPANY.

Parley J. Davis, Chairman and W. D. Huffaker Secretary, respectively, of a meeting of the stockholders of the Harrison Canal Company a Corporation, and President and Secretary of said corporation, held for the purpose of increasing the Capital Stock of said corporation being first duly sworn each for himself, says:

1st, That said meeting was called by a Majority vote of the Directors of said Corporation, for increasing the Capital Stock thereof.

2nd, That personal notice of the time and place of such meeting, and the object thereof was served on each stockholder resident in this State.

3rd, That said notice did contain the amount to which it was proposed to increase said Capital stock, being \$20,000.00 divided into 2,000 shares of \$10.00 each.

4th, That the number of shares of Capital Stock of said corporation is 2000, that at said meeting 1573 Shares were represented, being more than $\frac{2}{3}$ of the entire number of shares, and that all of said shares were voted in favor of so increasing said Capital Stock from \$10,000.00 to \$20,000.00-
