duly certified by the Recorder of Canyon County to be a true copy of the original articles on file in his office, was filed in this department on the second day of October A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred twenty-eight and is duly recorded in Book A-20 of Domestic Corporations, Records of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 4696 and 4871, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are constituted a body politic and corporate, by the name stated in the articles, and for a term of fifty years, and as such are entitled to all the rights and privileges granted to, and subject to the limitations of Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 196, Idaho Compiled Statutes.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF
"CENTRAL PARK LADIES AID"
OF
CENTRAL PARK, CANYON COUNTY, IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS; That we, the undersigned have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I.

That the name of this Corporation is "CENTRAL PARK LADIES AID", of Central Park, Canyon County, Idaho.

II.

That the purposes for which it is formed are: To conduct and maintain religious worship, to hold meeting of general interest to the community, and to acquire and hold such real and personal property as may be necessary, convenient and advantageous for the conduct and maintenance of religious worship and for holding meetings of general interest to the community, and to mortgage and dispose of the same in the manner conducive to the corporation and the purposes for which it is formed.

III.

That the principal place of business is to be transacted shall be Central Park, Canyon County, State of Idaho.

IV.

That the term for which it is to exist shall be fifty years from and after the date of its incorporation.

V.

That the number of directors shall be three, each of whom is to serve for a term of one year, or untill her or his successor is elected and qualified; provided, however, that a vacancy may be declared in the office of director by a majority

vote of the members present at a meeting properly called for that purpose; that the notice of such meeting must be publically announced at a meeting of the Central Park Ladies Aid at least two weeks prior to the date of such meeting, which said notice must give the date of such meeting and the time and place and purpose for which it is called.

That an election was held for the purpose of electing directors, at Central Park, Canyon County, Idaho, on the 28 day of September, 1928; that before such election was held, notice thereof was given by publication for at least two weeks in the Boise Valley Herald, a news paper published in the Village of Middleton, Canyon County, Idaho, and of general circulation within the Central Park neighborhood; there being no news paper printed or published in said last named neighborhood; that notice of such election was also given by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was held for the same length of time; that a majority of the members of such corporation were present at such meeting and voted at such election and the result thereof was the selection of the following named persons as trustees or directors of such corporation.
