CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-Five** and duly recorded on **----- microfilm** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Twin Falls** in the County of **Twin Falls.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MAUSS FINANCE COMPANY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, being natural persons and of full age and citizens of the United States and of the State of Idaho, by these presents associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the corporation laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify as follows:

I

That the name of the corporation is MAUSS FINANCE COMPANY.

II

That the corporation is formed for the following purposes:

To generally conduct a small loan business under the "Idaho Consumer Finance Act."

To lend money and to negotiate loans; to draw, accept, endorse, discount, buy, sell and deliver bills of exchange, promissory notes, bonds, debentures, coupons and other negotiable instruments and securities; to receive and accept transfers, pledges, mortgages and conditional sales contracts, and to deal with the same as owner, lender, factor or otherwise, as a means of security or of recovering money or property advanced, invested or loaned; to acquire, purchase, own, hold operate, develop, lease, mortgage, pledge, exchange, sell, transfer, invest, trade or otherwise deal in real and personal property, stocks, bonds,

securities, choses in action or any interest therein; to enter into contracts of any and every kind for the carrying out of its purposes and objects; to conduct investigations, credit and business researches, enter into profit sharing arrangements, promote organizations or cause to be organized any corporation, firm or partnership in aid of its business; to finance and aid by loan, subsidy, consignment or otherwise any corporation, association or other entity, and to conduct or cooperate in conducting any business or enterprise; to repossess by legal process or otherwise for the enforcement of any property rights, liens or interests it may be entitled to, and to carry on and undertake any business, undertaking, transaction or operation commonly carried on or undertaken by banks, promoters, merchants or other business which may seem to the company capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with the above or calculated, directly or indirectly, to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the corporation's property or rights.

To do all things necessary or incidental to the carrying on of a small loan business under the "Idaho Consumer Finance Act."

To exercise all authority conferred upon corporations by Section 30-114 of the Idaho Code, and, in addition thereto, to purchase its own stock and to enter it upon its books as treasury stock or to cancel it or re-issue it and in general to deal and trade in its own stock.

III

The corporation is to have perpetual existence, subject

only to dissolution in the manner provided by law.

IV

The location and postoffice address of the registered office of the corporation is 2108 Addison Avenue East, Twin Falls, Idaho.

V

The amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be and is Seventy-five Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$75,000.00) divided into 750 shares of the par value of One Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$100.00) per share.

VI

The names and postoffice addresses of each of the incorporators thereto and a statement of the number of shares subscribed by each is as follows:

VII

The private property of the stockholders of the corporation shall not be subject to the payment of the corporate debts to any extent whatever, and the shares of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment for the purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation or for any other

reason.

VIII

The number of directors of the corporation shall be as specified in the By-Laws, and such number may from time to time be increased or decreased in such manner as may be prescribed in the By-Laws, providing the number of directors of the corporation shall not be less than three. In case of any increase in the number of directors, the additional director may be elected by the directors then in office and the director so elected shall hold office until the next annual meeting of the stockholders and until their successors are elected and qualified.

The Board of Directors is expressly authorized to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and to adopt new By-Laws, and the corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, and repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Incorporation in the manner now or hereafter prescribed by law by a majority vote of the shareholders represented in person or by proxy at any annual meeting of the shareholders or at any meeting duly called for that purpose, except where the laws of the State of Idaho otherwise provide.

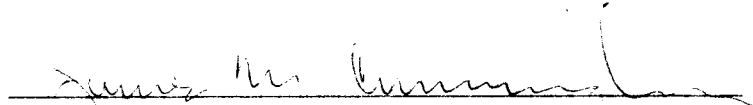
