The objects and purposes for which this corporation Second. is formed are as follows; To engage in the business of mining, smelting, regining, reducing and dealing with all kinds of ores, metals and minerals, and the prospecting for, locating, opening, operating and developing of mineral ground and mineral deposits of all and every description, together with appurtenances that may be necessary and incidental thereto.

Eleventh. The stockholders shall not be individually liable for the debts and liabilities of the corporation.

Twelfth. In all other respects the corporation shall be governed and empowered to act by and in accordance with
its bylaws and the laws of the State of Idaho as
found in the Compiled Statutes of Idaho, and all
