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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

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The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a non-profit corporation under the Idaho Non-Profit Corporation Act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is Information & Referral/Volunteer Connection, Inc.

ARTICLE II

The corporation shall be a non-profit corporation.

ARTICLE III

The period of its duration is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are as follows:

- 1) To provide a county-wide Information and Referral System to link people in need with available services. When the individual places the call for help, a trained specialist can quickly and accurately get to the core of the problem or question and refer the caller to the appropriate agency or service.
- 2) To provide a county-wide Volunteer Center to nurture volunteerism in the community by:
 - Matching volunteers with the most urgent community needs
 - Documenting the impact of volunteer involvement on critical community needs
 - Collaborating with all segments of the community to maximize the effect of volunteer involvement
- 3) To provide a system that integrates the Volunteer Center with the Information and Referral System that would in turn encourage cooperation and sharing of resources and responsibilities in the human service sector that would ultimately offer a better, more efficient and responsive service to our community.

ARTICLE V

The membership of the Corporation shall be open to all who share the goals to the stated purposes and meet membership requirements as stated in the By-Laws. Each member shall have one equal vote.

ARTICLE VI

The provisions for the regulation of the internal affairs of the Corporation shall be contained in the By-Laws, which shall be duly adopted by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VII

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation and the name of its initial registered agent at such street address is as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

Directors

The affairs of this Corporation shall be conducted by a Board of Directors, who shall be members of the Corporation. The Board shall consist of no less than the number required by the laws of the State of Idaho, and, under no circumstances, less than five. The numbers and qualifications of the Board of Directors shall be set forth in the By-Laws. The Board of Directors shall conduct all of the business of this corporation except that business specifically delegated to its executive committee and any other committee to which its authority may be lawfully related as it becomes necessary in the fulfillment of its corporate purposes.

ARTICLE IX

This corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

ARTICLE X

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be

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authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IX hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954.

ARTICLE XI

DISTRIBUTION OR DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of the Corporation, no member shall be entitled to any distribution or division of its remaining property or its proceeds, and the balance of all money and other property received by the Corporation from any source, after the payment of all debts and obligations of the Corporation shall be used or distributed exclusively for purposes within the intentment of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as the same now exists or as it may be amended from time to time.

ARTICLE XII

The name and address of each of the incorporators are as shown on Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, does make and file this agreement and has accordingly made, signed and acknowledged these Articles of Incorporation this 21st day of January, 1992.
