CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION
OF IDAHO FALLS LODGE NO.1087, BENEVOLENT
AND PROTECTIVE ORDER OF ELKS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA.

KNOW ALL MEN: That we, the undersigned, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the State of Idaho, and in pursuance of the purposes for which we have been elected, as hereinafter set forth, a benevolent corporation to be known as Idaho Falls Lodge No.1087, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.

And we certify, that the objects for which this corporation is formed are;

To establish, construct, maintain and operate in the City of Idaho Falls, Bingham County, Idaho, an Elks Home and in connection therewith to do all things necessary and appurtenant thereto under the supervision of the directors of this corporation, and to take charge of the home building, estate and property now belonging to or hereafter acquired by Idaho Falls Lodge No.1087, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks;

To borrow money for the purposes of the lodge and to pledge the property of the lodge as security for the payment thereof;

That the principal place of business of this corporation shall be the City of Idaho Falls in Bingham County, Idaho;

That the term of the incorporation shall be fifty years;

That all persons who are members of Idaho Falls Lodge No.1087, Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks shall be members of this corporation.

That the number of directors who shall have the management of its affairs as aforesaid, shall be three, and the names of the directors elected for the first year, are;

That said directors were duly elected at a regular meeting of the members of said Lodge duly convened and held in the Odd Fellows Hall building at Idaho Falls, Idaho, for the purpose, among other things, of electing the directors to take charge and management of its property and the matters and things pertaining thereto and to form this corporation. That a majority of said members were then and there present, and voted, at such election, for the above-named directors, as is more particularly set forth in the certificate and verification by the officers who conducted the election, hereto annexed and made a part of these articles.
