### CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho, filed in this office on the **twenty-third** day of **February**, 19 **39**, original articles of amendment, as provided by Section **30-1103, 30-1104, 30-1105, Idaho Code, amending Article 1, extending corporate existence from fifty years to perpetual,**

and that the said articles of amendment contain the statement of facts required by law, and are recorded on Film No. **106** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho.

CERTIFICATE IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 30-1104, IDAHO CODE

G. B. WILSON, Chairman, and MRS. JOHN DIXON, Secretary, of the Board of Trustees of the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Lapwai, Idaho, do hereby certify:

That the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Lapwai, Idaho, organized pursuant to provisions of R. C. Section 3011 (Sec. 1, Chapter 11, Title 30 of Idaho Code) filed its Articles of Incorporation with, and a certificate of incorporation was issued therefore, by the Secretary of State on March 20, 1909; that said Articles, in Article I thereof, provide the term for said corporation to be 50 years, said term to expire on March 20, 1959.

That the Board of Trustees of said corporation called a meeting of the members thereof for the purpose of amending the Articles of Incorporation by extending the period of its existence to make said term perpetual; that at said meeting so called, two-thirds of the members of the corporation present voted in favor of such amendment.

That notice of the time and place for the holding of the meeting of the members of said corporation was given by publication once a week for three weeks in the Lewiston Morning Tribune, a paper published in Nez Perce County, wherein Lapwai, Idaho, is situate, and by posting a copy thereof in a conspicuous place at the church, for the same period of three weeks, where said meeting was held; that pursuant to the actions so taken by two-thirds of the members of said corporation at said meeting, the Articles of Incorporation of the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Lapwai, Idaho, were amended as follows:

Article I: The corporate name of this church is the First Presbyterian Church of Fort Lapwai, and its location and chief place for transaction of its business are at Fort Lapwai, Nez Perce County, Idaho. The term for which this corporation

shall exist shall be perpetual.
