KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, the undersigned, being of full age and a citizen of the United States, and of the State of Idaho, do hereby form a professional corporation under the Laws of the State of Idaho, as contained in Title 30, Chapter 13 of the Idaho Code, known as the "Professional Service Corporation Act," and to that end I do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I

<u>NAME</u>

The name of the Corporation shall be John R. Coleman, Chtd.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are:

- (a) To engage in the professional practice of law as a professional corporation, as the same is now or hereafter defined by statute, rule, and regulation;
- (b) To invest in real property, personal property, mortgages, stocks, bonds, or any other types of investment, and to own or lease real or personal property necessary for the rendering of such professional services;
- (c) To engage in such other businesses or professions as may be authorized or permitted by the Professional Service ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 1

DURATION

The initial registered office of said Corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located at 156 2nd Avenue West, Twin Falls, Idaho. The Post Office address of the initial registered office is P. O. Box 525, Twin Falls, Idaho 83303-525. John R. Coleman shall be the initial registered agent at the address set forth above.

ARTICLE V

CORPORATION STOCK

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is 1,000, all of which shall have a par value of \$1.00 per share.

MANAGEMENT
