ARTICLES OF INCORPATION OF THE TWIN FALLS JAY_C_ETTLS, INC.

We, the undersigned, being all natural citizens of the United States and residents of Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, do on this 12th day of October, 1965, hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation of social, educational, benevolent and charitable character under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby adopt and certify the following articles of incorporation, to-wit:

ARTICLE I

That the name of this corporation shall be "The Twin Falls Jay-C-Ettes, Inc."

ARTICLE II

That the location of the principle office and the place where the principle business of said corporation is to be transacted is in the City of Twin Falls. County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

That the purpose for which said corporation is formed is as follows: To assist the Twin Falls Jaycees, Inc., as an auxillary, in vital projects such as youth welfare, Christmas and religious activities, governmental affairs, and the possibility of higher level in self development and leadership; to promote civic, industrial and educational activities of the community; and to offer a program of usefulness to the city, state, end nation; and to acquire, hold, own, use and dispose of in any manner all real and other property whatsoever as may be reasonably necessary for the purpose of carrying into effect any one or more of the objects herein before and herein after mentioned, and to mortgage, hypotecate, pledge, sell and otherwise dispose of said real or other property; to borrow money end to do all acts, and to make, execute and deliver all necessary instruments for the carrying on of the said purpose or purposes; and to enter contracts, to promote, manage, support, transact, or carry on any other business or bussinesses, whether manufacturing, trading, leasing, buying and selling, or either, or otherwise, which may seem to the corporation, capable of being conveniently carried on in connection with its business or interests or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable and useful any of the corporation's

property or rights, so long as such business or activity is not forbidden by the laws of the State of Idaho;

To act as factor, broker, or commission agent and to buy, sell and handle goods, wares, and merchandise under any lawful arrangement which to the corporation may seem proper; to acquire, own, use, enjoy, sell and dispose of patents and patent rights, trade marks, copyrights, licenses, and franchises of every kind whatsoever;

To borrow money, to lend money, and to evidence the indebtedness of the corporation by notes, bonds, or other instruments and to secure to same by pledge, mortgage, trust deed, or other instruments as to the corporation may seem proper; to acquire and to own stock, bonds, and securities of other corporations and while owning the same to exercise all the privileges of ownership consistent with the corporate character of this company;

To do any and all things convenient and incidental to the purposes herin expressed. and generally to have and exercise all such powers as are by law conferred on corporations of like character, and without any particular limiting of any powers or purposes of the corporation;

The business and purposes of the corporation shall be from time to time to do any one or more, or all of the acts and things herein set forth, and all such other acts, and things and business in any manner connected therewith or necessary, incidental, convenient, or auxiliary thereto, or calculated directly or indirectly to promote the interests of the corporation or enhance the value of any of its property or rights as such corporation may lawfully do; and in carrying on its business, or for the purpose of attaining any of its objects to do any and all things and to exercise any and all powers not prohibited by law, and either as or by and through principles, agents, attorneys, trustees, contractors, factors, lessors, leases, or other ise, either alone or in connection with others.

ARTICLE IV

Mat the term of existence of this corporation shall be fifty (50) years from and after the date of incorporation.

ARTICLE V

That this corporation has no capital stock.

ARTICLE VI

That the number of directors of this corporation shall be five (5). They shall have the management of the real estate of this corporation and their qualifications and terms of office, manner of election (except the first board of directors who were elected as set forth in Paragraph VIII hereof), time, place and manner of calling meetings and other powers and duties of the directors shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

AFTICIE VII

The officers of this corporation shall consist of a President, a Internal VicePresident, a External Vice-President, a Treasurer and a Secretary, in addition to
the directors listed above in Article VI, and their qualifications, terms of office
manner of election, time place, and manner of calling meetings and other powers and
duties of the officers shall be prescribed by the by-laws.

ARTICIE VIII

That a duly called meeting of the members of this corporation was held at its meeting place. Depot Grill, at Iwin Falls, Twin Falls County, Ideho on the 12th day of Cotober, 1965, at the hour of 7:30 P.H., at which meeting a majority of the members present voted for the election of directors and that notice of the time and place of holding such meeting and election was given by publication thereof, for two weeks prior to the said meeting, the Times News, a weekly newspaper, published in Twin Falls. Twin Falls County, State of Idaho, in the city where said election was held and was published in every Thursday issue thereof commencing with the 30th day of September, 1965, and ending with the 7th day of Cotober, 1965, and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place in the building where the said election was held for the same length of time immediately preceding such election, said notice being posted in Depot Grill on the 23th day of September, 1965, and remained posted therein to and including the 12th day of October, 1965.

ARTICLE X

That at said meeting mentioned in Article VIII, these articles of incorporation were by unanimous vote duly adopted and said persons so elected as directors were duly authorized and directed to excute and file the same for record and to duly incorporate said corporation for and on behalf of its members, according to law.
