KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that Wayne Ruberry, Lee Kelso and Sue Curtis, the undersigned, of Mountain Home, Bliss and Gooding, State of Idaho, respectively, being residents and natural persons of the age of twenty-one years or more and citizens of the State of Idaho, and the United States of America, acting as incorporators of a nonprofit corporation formed under and pursuant to the provisions of § 30-301, et seq., Idaho Code, do hereby adopt and execute the following articles of incorporation and do hereby certify and declare:

ARTICLE I

That the name of said corporation is and shall be THREE ISLAND TEAM PENNING ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purpose for which this corporation is formed and operated are including, but not limited to:

- (A) This nonprofit corporation shall be dedicated to the presentation, promotion and preservation of equestrian events for show, competition and pleasure.
- (B) To take, hold and receive all manner of gifts, inheritances, and estates of whatever kind or nature that may be created for, executed to and declared to belong to this body.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - 1

or otherwise, and to own, develop, explore, exploit, improve, operate, lease, enjoy, control, manage or otherwise turn to account and to mortgage, grant, sell, assign, exchange, convey or otherwise dispose of, in any country, state, locality, territory or dependents of the United States or any other country, any and all personal property, real estate, lands, options, concessions, grants, land patents, franchises, rights, privileges, easements, tenements, estates, hereditaments, interest, chattels and property or property rights of every description and nature whatsoever which the operation may deem wise, proper, necessary or convenient for the conduct and operation of the affairs of the corporation.

(D) Borrow or raise money, from time to time, and without limit, and upon any terms, in furtherance of any of the purposes of the corporation; to authorize the issuance of notes and other obligations or evidences of indebtedness of the corporation for monies so borrowed; and to secure the payment of the same and of the interest thereon by mortgage upon, or pledge conveyance, or assignment in trust of, the whole or any part of the property, real or personal of the corporation, and whether at the time owned or thereafter acquired.

(E) Enter into, make, execute, perform and carry out contracts of every kind and nature with any person, firm, association or corporation, which may be deemed necessary,

- (F) Arrange with any person, firm or corporation, the management of any of the business and affairs of the corporation for and on behalf of this corporation.
- (G) Do each and all things set forth herein to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do in the State of Idaho, and in any other state, country or place.

The foregoing clauses shall be construed as objects, purposes and powers; and it is hereby expressly provided that any enumeration of specific powers shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of this corporation or foundation.

(H) And to do all other things not otherwise prohibited by law.

ARTICLE III

That the location and post office address of the corporation shall be P.O. Box 362, Glenns Ferry, Elmore County, Idaho 63623, OR 1780 S. 18 W., MOUNTAIN HOME, IDAHO 83647

ARTICLE IV

That, subject to dissolution, in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - 3

In the event this corporation is ever dissolved, its assets are to be distributed to the Elmore County, Idaho 4-H Scholarship Fund.

ARTICLE VI

This corporation shall be open to membership and membership cards shall be issued to each member hereof. These membership cards shall not be assigned or transferred except upon the approval of a majority of the then duly elected officers of the association and upon such regulations as the Bylaws may prescribe. The rights and interests of all members in this corporation shall be equal.

ARTICLE VII

The private property of any member of the corporation shall not be subject to payment of corporate debts to any extent whatsoever, and the membership card shall not be subject to assessment for any purpose of paying expenses, conducting business or paying debts of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

The control and direction of the association shall be by its duly elected officers. The officers of the corporation shall be elected at the annual meeting of the corporation as provided by the Bylaws.
