was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **twentieth** day of **June** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-one** and is duly recorded on Film No. **67** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 29-108, 29-1101 and 29-1102, Idaho Code, Annotated.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Twin Falls** in the County of **Twin Falls**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WE, the Undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Corporation of the members of the Kiwanis Club of Twin Falls, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together as follows:

FIRST: That the name of said corporation shall be "KIWANIS CLUB OF TWIN FALLS, IDAHO, INC."

SECOND: That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1/ To give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than the material values of life.
2. To encourage the daily living of the Golden Rule in all human relationships.
3. To promote the adoption of and the application of higher social, business and professional standards.
4. To develop, by precept and example, a more intelligent, aggressive and serviceable citizenship.
5. To provide thru this club, a practical means to form enduring friendships, to render altruistic service and to build better communities.
6. To cooperate in creating and maintaining that sound public opinion and high idealism which make possible the increase of righteousness, justice, patriotism and good will.

To carry out the foregoing purposes the corporation shall have the power to receive, hold and convey real and personal property, and to receive, hold and distribute gifts of property of any and all kinds.

THIRD: That the term of said corporation shall be perpetual.

FOURTH: That the principal place of business shall be Twin Falls, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

FIFTH: There shall be no capital stock and no profit derived from said corporation.

SIXTH: That pursuant to notice duly published and legally given, at a regular meeting of said club, on June 14th, 1951, at the Legion Hall in Twin Falls, Idaho, an election was held and a majority of the members present voted for and elected the following members as a Board of Directors: R. J. Holmes, Orrin A. Fuller, O. A. Kelker, Charles E. Allen, Juneau Shinn, James Reynolds, Elvis Cain, Clarence Ford, K. M. Longbella, Paul Taber, jr, Wm Smith and Kenneth Montgomery, all of Twin Falls, Idaho. said members above being the regularly elected officers and directors including the Past President of said Club.
