### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, GEO. H. CURTIS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 29-103, 29-1101 and 29-1102, Idaho Code, Annotated.

**AND I FURTHER CERTIFY,** That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for perpetual existence from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho Falls** in the County of **Bonneville**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

**IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF,** I have hereunto set my hand and affixed the Great Seal of the State. Done at Boise City, the Capital of Idaho, this **28th** day of **August**, in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred **Forty-three**, and of the Independence of the United States of America the One Hundred **Sixty-eighth**.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

THE ASSEMBLY OF GOD OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS, IDAHO, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are residents and citizens of the State of Idaho, and whose post office addresses are as hereinafter stated, pursuant to the action of the members of The Assembly of God of the City of Idaho Falls, State of Idaho, a voluntary unincorporated church association, of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, formerly conducted under the name of Glad Tidings Assembly, of Idaho Falls, Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming, and we do hereby form, a corporation under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Idaho;

AND WE HEREBY CERTIFY AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the objects and purposes for which such corporation is formed are: To establish and conduct a church in the City of Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, Idaho, and in connection therewith, suitable and customary organizations, for the purpose of public worship and religious training, under the rules and discipline of The General Council of the Assemblies of God, Inc., a corporation of the State of Missouri, and to hold, and take title to, and charge of, the church building, estate and property and affairs and temporalities, of the association, heretofore conducted at Idaho Falls, Idaho by and under the name of The Assembly of God of the City of Idaho Falls, State of Idaho, and under its former name of Glad Tidings Assembly of Idaho Falls, Idaho, an unincorporated association, and of all property and estate and the affairs and temporalities of the corporation.

2. That the name of said corporation shall be:

THE ASSEMBLY OF GOD OF THE CITY OF IDAHO FALLS,  
IDAHO, INC.

3. That the term and duration of said corporation shall be perpetual.

4. That the principal place of business and the location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation, in the State of Idaho is, and shall be, the City of Idaho Falls, in Bonneville County, Idaho.

5. That the corporation shall have no capital stock nor shares of stock and that said corporation is not organized for the object or purpose of pecuniary profit.

6. That the number of Directors of said corporation, who shall have the management of the affairs as aforesaid of said corporation, shall be three, and the names of the Directors elected to serve, until their respective successors are elected, and their terms of office, are as follows:

Melville R. Casper, whose post office address is 542  
K Street, Idaho Falls, Idaho, to serve until  
the annual election of the corporation in January  
of 1944.

Lyle L. Casper, whose post office address is, Route 2, Idaho Falls, Idaho, to serve until the annual election of the corporation in January of 1945.

Winston K. Casper, whose post office address is, Route 2, Idaho Falls, Idaho, to serve until the annual election of the corporation in January of 1946.

The respective successors of said Directors shall each serve a term of three years from and after their respective elections and shall be elected at the annual meetings of the corporation to be held at the time fixed by its By-Laws.

7. The Constitution and By-laws, as adopted by said association on January 6, 1943, except as otherwise provided by these Articles, or by the laws of Idaho, are hereby adopted as, and the same shall be, until repealed or amended, the By-laws of the corporation.

8. That the incorporation of the said unincorporated association was determined and authorized and the said Directors were duly elected at a meeting of the members of said unincorporated association, duly convened and held at the church of said association, located at the corner of Fifteenth Street and Lee Avenue in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, on the 28th day of July, 1943, at 8:00 P. M. of said day, and that at such meeting said Directors were authorized and empowered to form this corporation and to adopt these Articles of Incorporation, and that a majority of the members of said association were then and there present, at such meeting, and voted, at such meeting, for, and such members elected, the above named Directors, and that said meeting of the members of said association was duly called, convened and held for the purpose of considering the question of incorporating said association under the laws of Idaho, and if so determined, to elect not less than three, nor more than thirty-five Directors of the corporation and to authorize and provide for the formation of the corporation, and that notice of the time and place of holding such meeting and election was duly given by publication for two weeks in a newspaper published in the City of Idaho Falls, Idaho, the City in which said meeting was held, and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place on the building where such election was to be held, for the same length of time. That the Rev'd John F. Green was elected to preside and he presided and Miss Mabel Casper was elected to act and she acted as secretary of the said meeting.
