

## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR DAIRY EQUIPMENT SPECIALIST, INC., A CLOSE CORPORATION



- 1. The corporation will be known as DAIRY EQUIPMENT SPECIALIST, INC.
- 2. The corporation will be incorporated in the State of Idaho, although it may do business in other States and Countries.
- 3. The corporation is to be incorporated as a close corporation incorporated pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho.
  - 4. The corporation intends to elect Subchapter S status.
  - 5. The corporation's duration will be perpetual.
- 6. The corporation is formed for any legally permitted purposes, including, but not limited to, dairy equipment repair and service.
- 7. The corporation's initial and continuing registered agent is Dennis C. Hunt; the corporation's initial and continuing registered address is 238 West 300 North, Jerome, Idaho, 83338.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION - 1

- 9. The corporation will be ultimately governed by its shareholders. However, a Board of Directors does exist, each member of which must be a shareholder. The Board of Directors shall undertake the daily business of the corporation and shall delegate any powers and authority as the Board of Directors deems necessary for such day to day activities. The board of Director's actions may be approved, repealed, rejected or otherwise changed by a vote of the shareholders.
  - 10. The corporation is authorized to issue 1000 shares of no-par common stock.
- 11. As long as the corporation has a valid Subchapter S election, no other stock than one class of common stock shall be issued. All stock shall have equal voting rights.
- 12. All shares of the corporation's stock issued at a time when the corporation is a close corporation will be subject to the following transfer and preemptive right restrictions. The shareholders shall have an exclusive right to buy back any shares which may become available. No shareholder shall have any right to transfer any stock in any manner whatsoever other than to allow existing shareholders reasonable opportunity to exercise their exclusive right to buy back available shares. Dennis C. Hunt shall have the first priority right to buy back any available shares. Linda J. Hunt shall have the second priority right to buy back any available shares after Dennis C. Hunt has had reasonable opportunity to exercise his right to buy back. Thereafter, other shareholders shall be equally free to exercise their exclusive rights to buy back any available shares.
- 13. A meeting of shareholders will be held, either inside or outside the State of incorporation, at least once a year. One of the meetings shall be held annually on the annually of day of which, each year beginning in 1995 at 2.00 o'clockp.m. at the registered
