ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF THE RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF ASHLAND OIL & REFINING COMPANY

AMENDMENT NO. 1

Know all Men by these presents, that Orin E. Atkins, as President, and John P. Ward, as an Assistant Secretary of Ashland Oil & Refining Company, a Kentucky corporation, do hereby certify that, at a meeting on January 20, 1969 of the holders of its issued and outstanding stock which meeting was was duly called upon notice of the specific purpose, the holders of more than two-thirds (%) of the outstanding shares of Common Stock and more than a majority of the voting power of all shareholders entitled to vote, adopted the following resolutions and amendment of the Restated Articles of Incorporation of said Company:

RESOLVED, that ARTICLE FOURTH of the Restated Articles of Incorporation of the Corporation, be and the same hereby is, amended so that the first literary paragraph of ARTICLE FOURTH shall read as follows:

FOURTH: The total number of shares which the Company is authorized to issue is (A) 3,000,000 shares of Cumulative Preferred Stock, without par value (hereinafter called Preferred Stock), and (B) 60,000,000 shares of Common Stock, par value \$1.00 per share (hereinafter called Common Stock).

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the description of the respective classes of stock of the Company and the statement of the voting powers, designations, preferences and rights and the qualifications, limitations or restrictions granted to or imposed upon the shares of each class as set forth in the previous Restated Articles of Incorporation are unchanged.
