

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
NINE MILE MINING COMPANY.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, John W. Flink, Ole Linn, Patrick J. Gearon, James A. Kauffman, Charles Bergstrom, William W. Woods and A. G. Kerns, all of the County of Shoshone, State of Idaho, do voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation and becoming a body politic corporate under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we hereby declare and set forth:

First.

The name of this corporation is and shall be the

NINE MILE MINING COMPANY.

Second.

This corporation is formed for the purpose of purchasing, selling, buying, leasing, working and operating mines and mining claims, water rights, millsites and easements incident thereto, and such other property as may be lawfully acquired by a corporation under the laws of the United States of America, the State of Idaho, and elsewhere; purchasing, renting, leasing and building mills, concentrators and other works and machinery necessary for the purpose of milling, concentrating, reducing and handling ores and the products thereof; buying, selling, working, milling and concentrating ores.

Third.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be in the City of Wallace, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

Fourth.

This corporation shall exist for a term of fifty years.

Fifth.

The officers of this corporation shall consist of five; the names and residence of those who are appointed for the first year or until the first annual meeting of the stockholders are as follows:

W. W. Woods, Director and President, Wallace, Idaho;

John W. Flank, Director and Vice-President, Wallace, Idaho;

Ole Lahn, Director and Treasurer, Wallace, Idaho;

Patrick J. Gearon, Director, Wallace, Idaho;

A. G. Kerns, Director and Secretary, Wallace, Idaho.

Sixth.

That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be one million shares, and shall be divided into one million shares of the par value of ~~one cent~~ ^{ten cents} each.

This stock is declared to be fully paid upon the consideration following: The corporation pays seven hundred thousand shares of the capital stock of said company for the conveyance to it of the "Speckled Trout", "Pierce", "Star", "Hell", "Aina" and an undivided half of the "Topeka" lode mining claims situated in Placer Center Mining District, County of Shoshone, State of Idaho.

The amount of capital stock actually subscribed and fully paid in is seven hundred thousand shares, in addition to three hundred thousand shares set aside for development purposes and called Treasury Stock. 
