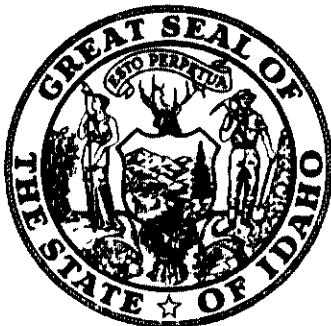

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, the undersigned, being a natural person of full age and a citizen of the United States, in order to form a nonprofit corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, under and pursuant to the provisions of the Idaho Nonprofit Corporation Act, Chapter 3, Title 30, Idaho Code (the "Act"), and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of the Corporation is CENTRAL RIM NEIGHBORHOOD ASSOCIATION, INC. (the "Association").

ARTICLE II. NONPROFIT STATUS

The Association is a nonprofit corporation.

ARTICLE III. PERIOD OF DURATION

The period of duration of the Association is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV. PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Association is organized and will be operated are as follows:

1. To identify neighborhood problems and needs, to assist in the development and implementation of programs which respond to these problems and needs, and to provide an ongoing opportunity for citizen participation in the decision-making processes of government in a positive and productive manner.

2. To exercise all powers granted by law necessary and proper to carry out the above-stated purposes, including but not limited to the power to accept grants, donations of money, property, whether real or personal, or any other thing of value. Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to authorize or permit the Association to carry on any business for profit, to exercise any power, or to do any act that a corporation formed under the Act, or any amendment thereto or substitute therefor, may not at that time lawfully carry on or do.

ARTICLE V. INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The location and the physical address of the initial registered office of the Association and its registered agent is the residence of the current President of the Association, in Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho. The Association may have such other offices as may from time to time be designated by its Board of Directors.

ARTICLE VI. MEMBERS

The Association shall have one class of members who shall have such rights as are provided in the Act and are consistent with the Bylaws and the management authority that these Articles grant the Board of Directors of the Association.

ARTICLE VII. MEMBERSHIP DUES

Membership dues shall be charged to all members in equal amounts. The members shall fix the amount of membership dues from time to time, and dues shall be payable at such times or intervals, and upon such notice, and by such methods as the Board of Directors may prescribe. Should dissolution of the corporation occur, any assets remaining shall be returned to the Membership.

ARTICLE VIII. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall consist of not less than four(4) nor more than sixteen(16) individuals, each of whom, at all times, shall be a member of the Association. The actual number of Directors shall be fixed by the Bylaws of the Association, and the initial number of Directors shall be four(4). Other than the Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors, who are designated in these Articles, the Directors shall be elected or appointed by the members in the manner and for the term provided in the Bylaws of the Association.
