I, J. D. (CY) PRICE, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **fourth** day of **August** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **twenty-eight** and is duly recorded on Film No. **35** of Record of Domestic Corporations of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Sections 29-103, 29-1101 and 29-1102, Idaho Code, Annotated.

AND I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name stated in the articles, and for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Idaho** in the County of **Ada**, and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Religious, Ex-Service Men, Benevolent, Charitable and Fraternal Corporations, as provided in Chapter 11, Title 29, Idaho Code, Annotated.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Kuna GRANGE NO. 59 PATRONS OF HUSBANDRY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we the undersigned, have associated ourselves together, and do hereby under and pursuant to the laws of Idaho, associate ourselves together, forming a non-profit, cooperative and Fraternal grange organization, and hereby adopt the following as articles of incorporation under which said organization shall operate.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be Kuna Grange No. 59 Patrons of Husbandry, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The express powers and purposes of this corporation shall be:

- (a) To promote both generally and specially the interests of its members engaged in agricultural pursuits.
- (b) To cooperate with similar organizations in the State and with the State and National organizations for the purpose of interesting legislative bodies to do such things and provide such acts as will in general benefit agriculture throughout the entire country.
- (c) To participate in and assist in the development and operation of cooperative organizations.
- (d) To provide better markets for agricultural products of the members and for the purchase of any article of merchandise required by such members.
- (e) To own and control property real and personal.
- (f) To sell, assign, or lease the same and to do and perform any and all acts in furtherance and to the benefit of the agriculture industry and the Fraternal order of Patrons of Husbandry which are not contrary to the laws of Idaho or of the United States.
- (g) To borrow or lend money, to pledge, mortgage, or hypothecate property as security for the payment of any debt or obligation, and to do so at any and all times necessary to carry out the general purposes.

ARTICLE III.

The principal place of business of this organization shall be Kuna, County of Ada, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

The term of this organization shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE V.

The powers of this corporation shall be exercised by a board of not less than five nor more than twenty-five trustees, the exact number thereof to be determined by the members at their annual meeting each year. The members at such annual meeting, shall elect such trustees by vote, and such trustees shall hold offices for three years, but the first term of said trustees shall be one, two, or three years so that an equal proportion of such terms will expire each year as the total trustees bears to the term of three years. Intention being to stagger the terms of said trustees so that no more than a proportionate amount of the terms of said trustees will expire in any one year. Such trustees shall hold their offices for such terms and until their successors are elected and/or appointed and qualified. Vacancies in the board of trustees from any cause shall be filled by the remaining trustees until the end of the unexpired term or the next ensuing election. The duly elected Master and Secretary of this organization shall be ex officio members of said board of trustees without further election. That the trustees duly elected for their first terms at the organization meeting of this corporation, and their terms are as follows:

Husbandry; that on the 18th day of June, 1948, at the hour of 9.30 o'clock,
at Kuna, Ada County, State of Idaho, an election was held by the members of the afore-
